

STREET TRADING

- 1. Street Trading within the Borough is only permitted if you have a licence issued by the Council under the London Local Authorities Act 1990 as amended.
- 2. The Council has <u>designated certain roads</u> and sites as being suitable for Street Trading. For more information please refer to the relevant web page for the type of licence you require, <u>front of shop</u> or <u>designated site</u>.
- 3. Any vacancies will be advertised it on the council's street trading vacancy webpage.
- 4. Please be aware that all current permanent designated sites are in use. However, if you find a site you think may be suitable for street trading, ie the creation of a new designated site, please query this by writing to this office giving the details of:
 - The site (including a plan of the location)
 - The goods you wish to sell plus details of your vehicle or stall
 - The hours you propose to trade.
- 5. New designations are occasionally issued; but you should note that the Council is required by law to advertise new applications and consult locally before considering the matter at a meeting of the Licensing Committee. Please be aware there is no guarantee your application will be approved, and the process could take several months to complete.
