

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (FREE PARKING PLACES) (LIMITED TIME) (AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER 2010

Made: 1 February 2010

Coming into operation: 8 February 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 8 February 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2010.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Limited Time) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though there were added to the items in Schedule 14 to that Order the item numbered 14/1 and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order.

PARKING PLACES IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE MAXIMUM PARKING PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IS TWO HOURS.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order makes permanent the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2008 which introduced a free parking place in Station Road, Hampton, outside Nos 115-123 Hampton Road, where parking is limited to a maximum stay of 2 hours with no return within 1 hour on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between the hours of 8.30am and 6.30pm.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This order makes permanent the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Free parking Places) (Limited Time) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2008. Having considered the effect which the experimental order has had in terms of usefulness to local residents and to businesses, the Council is satisfied that its provisions should be continued on a permanent basis.
