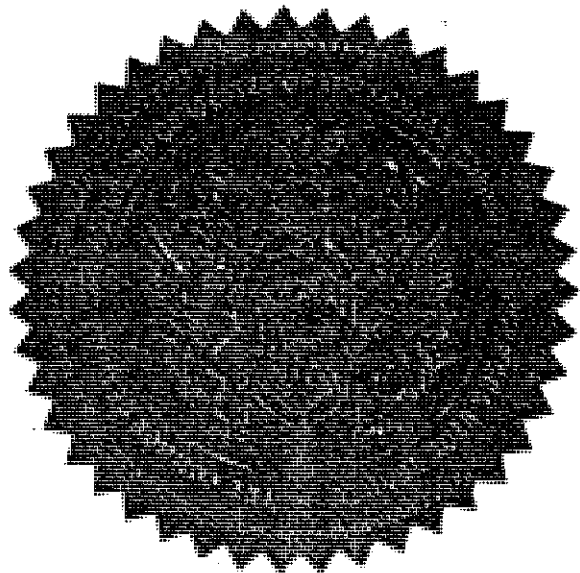
Coming into operation 21st September 1987

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on 21st September 1987 and may be cited as The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Second Cross Road, Twickenham) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1987.
- 2 Except as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in that length of Second Cross Road, Twickenham which lies between its junctions with Hampton Road and Staines Road in a direction other than from south-east to north-west.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to -
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (b) any person who causes or permits any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
