**The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes)
(Richmond) Regulations 1963**

The Minister of Transport, after consulting the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 34 of the Road Traffic Act 1960(a), as amended by section 8 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act 1960(b), and of all other powers him enabling in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 25th February 1963, and may be cited as the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Richmond) Regulations 1963.

(2) The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. 29) (Richmond) Regulations 1939(c) as having effect by virtue of section 267 (2) of and paragraph 1 of the 19th Schedule to the Road Traffic Act 1960 (which Regulations instituted one-way traffic working in Lower George Street, Richmond) are hereby revoked.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act these Regulations were an Act of Parliament and the Regulations revoked by paragraph (2) of this Regulation were an Act of Parliament thereby repealed.

2. Every vehicle entering any of the streets or lengths of street in the Borough of Richmond specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these Regulations shall, between the point of its entry therein and the point of its departure therefrom, follow the direction prescribed in relation to that street or length of street in column 2 of the said Schedule.

3. No vehicle shall enter or leave Lower George Street at its junctions with Eton Street, The Square and Sheen Road.

Any person who being in charge of any vehicle shall, except by the express direction or permission of a police constable in uniform, cause that vehicle to proceed in contravention of these Regulations shall be liable on summary conviction in the case of a first offence to a fine not exceeding £5, or in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding £10.

SCHEDULE

THE BOROUGH OF RICHMOND

1. <i>Street or length of street</i>	2. <i>Direction</i>
1. Duke Street.	From north-west to south-east.
2. Eton Street.	From north-west to south-east.
3. George Street, excluding the roadways on the east and south sides of the small triangular island site occupied by public conveniences at the junction of George Street with Lower George Street.	From south-west to north-east.
4. Paradise Road, between Eton Street and Red Lion Street.	From east to west.
5. Red Lion Street.	From east to west.
6. The Square, between George Street and Eton Street.	From north-west to south-east.
