Dear Occupier/Owner

Teddington controlled parking zone study

In December 2007 / January 2008 the Council consulted a number of roads around Teddington Station on a proposal to introduce a controlled parking zone (CPZ). The results of the consultation showed that there was support in a number of roads around the station which includes your road. These results were reported to the Transport Consultative Group on 30 January 2008. After this meeting the Cabinet Member approved the implementation of the CPZ to these eleven roads around the station (see map overleaf).

For your information, the decision to implement the CPZ was subsequently referred to the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Committee on Tuesday 26 February 2008. The Committee accepted the Cabinet Member's decision to implement the CPZ. However, in the light of further representations (including petitions and surveys from local residents) and consideration of the consultation results, the Committee requested that residents of Avenue Road, Blackmores Grove, and Field Lane, be re-consulted to see whether they would wish to be included in this CPZ. The results of this consultation, which is now underway, will be analysed and reported to the Cabinet Member in late April / early May 2008. As per previous consultations, the results will be analysed on a road by road basis and a decision made as to whether or not to include one or more of these roads in the CPZ.

Your application packs for both parking permits are scheduled to be sent by post around the end of May 2008. **The new CPZ will come into operation on Monday 16 June 2008 and will operate between 8.30am and 10.30am, Monday to Friday.** The Council will review the operation of the CPZ after approximately three months of implementation.

Work to implement the CPZ, involving the installation of lines and signs in roads within the CPZ, is scheduled to commence in late April 2008 / early May 2008, weather permitting. Due to limited access to some roads and a high parking demand, we may need to move cars to install the markings. This will not involve the towing away of any vehicles and/or the issue of penalty charge notices for parking areas scheduled for installation of markings.

National Grid gas works are scheduled to commence in Albert Road and Victoria Road in May. We will be coordinating the CPZ implementation works with the gas works to minimise their impact in the area.

Further details of the decision to implement the CPZ and all yellow line proposals both inside and outside the CPZ boundary are available for inspection at Teddington Library, Council Offices, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham and on the Council website:

The Council will review the operation of the new CPZ after approximately three months of implementation.
