
TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 25) ORDER 2009

Made: 28 September 2009

Coming into operation: 5 October 2009

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 5 October 2009 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 25) Order 2009.
2.
 - (1) In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though for the item numbered 324A in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order varies the extent of the waiting restrictions “no waiting at any time” on the east side of Hawkesley Close, Twickenham, such that they extend for a distance of 4 metres from its junction with Waldegrave Park.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council has made an order (TMO 2009/25), one provision of which is that waiting restrictions “no waiting at any time” were to extend for a distance of 5 metres on the east side of Hawkesley Close, Twickenham.

Following representations from residents, the Council considers that a reduction in the length of these restrictions by 1 metre will have no significant adverse effect on road safety, and will reduce the pressure on-street parking.
