TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 30) ORDER 2010

Made: 1 February 2010

Coming into operation: 22 February 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 22 February 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 30) Order 2010.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though for the item numbered 666 in Schedule 1 to that Order there was substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order:-

- (a) introduces an addition length of waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") on the south-west side of Stanley Road, Teddington; and
- (b) corrects an error in the previous order so as to describe more accurately the extent of the existing double yellow lines in Stanley Road (from its junction with Broad Street/Hampton Road to outside the Teddington Methodist Church).

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The additional length of waiting restriction "no waiting at any time" on the south-west side of Stanley Road will have an overall length of 11 metres and will be located on the exit side of a bus stop and bus stop clearway. The waiting restriction will prevent parking at two entrances to private property and will be of benefit to buses when leaving the bus stop.
