TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 56) ORDER 2010

Made: 6 December 2010

Coming into operation: 20 December 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 December 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 56) Order 2010.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the items numbered 657 and 789 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order: and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered 378A, 546A, 559A, 573A, 717A and 789A and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time" and "no waiting between 10am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive") in lengths of Trehern Road, Sheen and surrounding streets.

To avoid confusion and to improve enforcement, the part of White Hart Lane which lies to the south of the level crossing is known in this order as "White Hart Lane, Barnes" and the part which lies to the north of the level crossing as "White Hart Lane, Mortlake". These are allocated the item numbers 789 and 789A respectively.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council, having consulted with residents in the neighbouring streets as to the desirability of extending the East Sheen controlled parking zone has concluded there is a consensus view from residents that the zone should be extended into Trehern Road only. This will be of benefit to residents in that they will have priority parking in this street during the working day.

The Council is also proposing to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at road junctions along South Worple Way and Princes Road on the grounds of road safety and to alleviate hazardous conditions caused by congestion and poor sight lines.

This Order, therefore, introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of:-

Princes Road; and

South Worple Way;

and at the junctions of:-

South Worple Way with White Hart Lane, Barnes;

South Worple Way with The Retreat;

South Worple Way with Queens Road;

South Worple Way with Trehern Road;

Princes Road with Trehern Road:

Princes Road with Kings Road; and

Princes Road with Queens Road.

This Order also provides for waiting restrictions during the hours of control (between 10am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive) in Trehern Road, other than where double yellow lines are proposed.

A separate order makes the necessary provisions to extend the zone, to introduce resident permit holder parking bays in Trehern Road and designate certain addresses in Trehern Road, South Worple Way and Princes Road as being eligible for the purpose of applying for parking permits.

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 6 December 2010 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the East Sheen Parking Places Amendment Order is to:-
 - (a) extend the East Sheen controlled parking zone controls such that they include Trehern Road, Sheen; and
 - (b) include all addresses in Trehern Road, Nos 49 and 50 South Worple Way and Nos 18 and 20 Princes Road, Sheen as being qualifying addresses for the purpose of allowing residents to apply for parking permits.

Further particulars are given in paragraph 5 below.

- 3. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** is to make alterations to waiting restrictions as follows:-
 - (a) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting between 10am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive" in Trehern Road anywhere where there are no designated parking bays or other waiting restrictions, including the length specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; and
 - (b) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at certain road junctions and at certain vehicular access points as specified in Schedule 2.
- 4. The scheme, as proposed, has been modified by these orders insofar as the parking place on the west side of Trehern Road outside the flank of No 20 Princes Road has been shortened, a single yellow line, as specified in Schedule 1, has been introduced to allow access to a previously-existing vehicular crossover, and the double yellow line at the junction of Trehern Road with Princes Road has been extended by 2 metres in Trehern Road to prevent parked vehicles from obstructing access to a doorway.
- 5. The hours of control of the East Sheen CPZ are between 10am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive. In Trehern Road, parking bays for resident permit holders only will be introduced on both sides other than where there is an existing disabled persons parking bay and other than where double yellow lines are proposed (see Schedule). The charge for a parking permit depends on the engine size or CO2 emissions of the vehicle in respect of which the permit will be issued and the number of

months for which the permit will be valid. An additional charge is payable if the permit is the second or subsequent residents permit issued for any one household or the second or subsequent business permit issued for any one business user. Details of these charges, and for residents' visitors permits ("RVPs") are available on request. Each RVP is valid for a morning (10am - 2pm) or afternoon (12.30 - 6.30pm) period, and two permits will be required for a full day.

- 6. The Council has recently advertised its proposals for an alteration to the manner in which charges for parking charges (including permits) will be calculated. If and when such changes are brought into force, the particulars given in paragraph 5 above will be superseded by any such alterations.
- 7. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 20 December 2010, plans showing the location and effect of the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders:-
 - (c) can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 93/10, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

Persons wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

South Worple Way / White Hart Lane / The Retreat

White Hart Lane, the west side, for 5 metres to the south of South Worple Way; South Worple Way, the north side, from White Hart Lane to The Retreat; South Worple Way, the south side, from White Hart Lane to a point 5 metres west of The Retreat:

The Retreat, both sides, for 5 metres from South Worple Way.

South Worple Way / Queens Road

South Worple Way, the south side, for 5 metres either side of Queens Road; Queens Road, both sides, for 5 metres from South Worple Way.

South Worple Way / Trehern Road

South Worple Way, the south side, for 5 metres either side of Trehern Road; Trehern Road, both sides, for 5 metres from South Worple Way.

(b) in the following lengths of street:

Princes Road: the north side, for 8.5 metres at the entrance to Rock Avenue.

South Worple Way, Barnes:

The south side:

at the principal vehicular entrance to Barnes Hospital (10 metres on the east side, 5 metres on the west side);

at the principal vehicular exit from Barnes Hospital (5 metres on either side);

at the westernmost (or side) vehicular access to Barnes Hospital (19 metres overall length);

at the vehicular access to Mortlake cemetery (5 metres on either side).
