TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 67) ORDER 2011

Made: 20 June 2011

Coming into operation: 27 June 2011

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 27 June 2011 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 67) Order 2011.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(**b**) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the items numbered 92, 447, 532, 541, 547, 666, 776 and 802 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and as set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered 129A, 409B, 419A, 591A and 627A and as set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order:-

(a) introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of:-

Bushy Park Road (the cul-de sac on the south side of the railway line and adjoining Sandy Lane, Teddington);

Chilton Avenue, Whitton, at its junction with Powder Mill Lane;

Lindum Road, Hampton Wick at its junction with Wick Road;

Longford Road, Whitton at its junction with Powder Mill Lane;

Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the north-east side, at its junction with Longford Road and outside Heathfield Nursery School;

Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the south-west side, outside Nos 71-77 Powder Mill Lane;

Ross Road, Whitton (both sides at its junction with Percy Road and one side only on the inside of the sharp corner to the rear of the Whitton Methodist Church hall);

Windmill Road, Hampton Hill at its junction with School Road;

(b) introduces new waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 5pm") in lengths of:-

Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the south-west side, outside Nos 51-69 and Nos 79-93 Powder Mill Lane;

(c) varies existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 9.30am") to new restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in a length of:-

Mays Road, Teddington at its junction with Wellington Road, Teddington;

Percy Road, Whitton (the south-east side, for 5 metres on the north-east side of Ross Road);

(d) varies existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8am and 6.30pm") to new restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of:-

Wellington Road, Teddington (for 10 metres on each side of Mays Road)

(e) revokes existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of:-

Bushy Park Road (the south-east side, a distance of 45 metres, being a restriction first introduced by way of a temporary traffic order)

Mays Road, Teddington (the south side, a distance of 10 metres);

WLCEA AO67 Batch 42 2011/24 Princes Road, Teddington (the north side, at its junction with Stanley Road, a distance of 5 metres);

Stanley Road, Teddington (the south-west side, to the south-east of its junction with Princes Road, a distance of 3 metres);

Stanley Road, Teddington (the south-west side, outside Nos 119-121 Stanley Road Princes Road, a distance of 5 metres);

Stanley Road, Teddington (the south-west side, outside No 149 Stanley Road, a distance of 6 metres);

(f) revokes existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 5pm") in lengths of:-

Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the north-east side, opposite Nos 79-91 Powder Mill Lane (approximately 70 metres).

This Order further alters the designation of Wellington Road from "Wellington Road, Teddington" to Wellington Road, Hampton Hill".

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 20 June 2011 made the above Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order is to:-
 - (a) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in lengths of streets as specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
 - (b) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 5pm" in Powder Mill Lane, Whitton as specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
 - (c) vary existing waiting restrictions "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 9.30am" to new restrictions "no waiting at any time" in Percy Road, Whitton as specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
 - (d) vary existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8am and 6.30pm") to new restrictions ("no waiting at any time") at the junction of Wellington Road, Hampton Hill with Mays Road as specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;
 - (e) vary existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8am and 6.30pm") to new restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Sundays between 8am and 6.30pm") in a separate length of Wellington Road, Hampton Hill near its junction with South Road as specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;
 - (f) revoke existing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in lengths of streets as specified in Schedule 6 to this notice;
 - (g) revoke existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Saturdays between 8am and 6.30pm") in a length of Mays Road, Teddington as specified in Schedule 7 to this notice; and
 - (h) revoke existing waiting restrictions ("no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 5pm") in lengths of Powder Mill Lane, Whitton as specified in Schedule 8 to this notice.

- 3. The general effect of the **Loading Places Amendment Order** is to introduce a loading bay in Stanley Road, Teddington outside Nos 113-117 Stanley Road, having a length of 12 metres. It will be in operation on Mondays to Saturdays between 8am and 6.30pm, and vehicles will be allowed to stay in the bay for a maximum of 1 hour for the purposes of loading and unloading goods.
- 4. The general effect of the **Limited Time Amendment Order** is to introduce three limited time parking bays in Stanley Road, Teddington:
 - (a) outside Nos 91-93 Stanley Road (with a length of 11 metres);
 - (b) outside Nos 119-121 Stanley Road (with a length of 11 metres); and
 - (c) outside Nos 188-196 Stanley Road (with a length of 24.7 metres).
- 5. The parking bays referred to in paragraph 4 above will operate for the same days and hours as the loading bay specified in paragraph 3. The maximum stay for which vehicles may park will be 1 hour, and no return will be permitted within 1 hour of leaving the bay. There will be no charge for parking in these bays.
- 6. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 27 June 2011, plans showing the location and effect of the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 35/11, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and
 - (b) may be viewed on the Council's web-site at http://www.richmond.gov.uk/traffic management orders.htm
- 5. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Environment Directorate, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.
- 6. Persons wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 1

Waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time"

- (a) Bushy Park Road, the cul-de sac on the south side of the railway line and adjoining Sandy Lane, Teddington:
 - (i) the north-west side outside Nos 118-120 Bushy Park Road, for
 - 10 metres; and
 - (ii) the north-west side outside No 110 Bushy Park Road and at its junction with Sandy Lane, for 10 metres.

See also Schedule 6, item (a).

(b) Chiltern Avenue, Whitton: for 15.5 metres on the south-east side and for 13 metres on the north-west side at its junction with Powder Mill Lane.

- (c) Lindum Road, Hampton Wick: for 5 metres on both sides at its junction with Wick Road.
- (d) Longford Road, Whitton: for 12 metres on the south-east side and for 8 metres on the north-west side at its junction with Powder Mill Lane.
- (e) Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the north-east side: for 15 metres on the south-east side and for 45 metres on the north-west side (outside Heathfield Nursery School) at its junction with Longford Road.
- (f) Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the south-west side: for 35 metres outside Nos 71-77 Powder Mill Lane.
- (g) Powder Mill Lane, Whitton, the south-west side: at its junction with Chiltern Avenue, for 15 metres outside No 95 Powder Mill Lane and for 10.5 metres outside No 97 Powder Mill Lane.
- (h) Ross Road, Whitton: on both sides at its junction with Percy Road for 10 metres and on one side only on the inside of the sharp corner to the rear of the Whitton Methodist Church hall for 20 metres overall.
- (i) School Road, Hampton Hill, both sides: at its junction with Windmill Road, for 8.5 metres.
- (j) Windmill Road, Hampton Hill, the south-west side: for 5 metres on each side of School Road.

- 2. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to:-
 - (a) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in lengths of streets as specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
 - (b) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 5pm" in Powder Mill Lane, Whitton as specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
 - vary existing waiting restrictions "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 9.30am" to new restrictions "no waiting at any time" in Percy Road, Whitton as specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THESE ORDERS

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and may come from residents, Councillors or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

The waiting and loading restriction Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" and various other changes at the locations listed below. Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

Lindum Road, Hampton Wick, junction with Wick Road School Road, Hampton Hill, junction with Windmill Road Powder Mill Lane, Whitton (including Longford Road and Chiltern Avenue) Mays Road, Teddington, junction with Wellington Road Ross Road, Whitton

Sections of single yellow line are being removed from Powder Mill Lane, Whitton outside Heathfield School to increase available parking in conjunction with new restrictions on the south side of the road mentioned above.

Sections of double yellow lines are being removed where considered appropriate and with no adverse affects on vehicle flow or safety, on Stanley Road, Teddington (between Princes Road and Fulwell Road) and in Bushy Park Road, Teddington.

The Council is intending to introduce a loading bay on the west side of Stanley Road, Teddington outside Nos 68-78 High Street for the benefit of local shops and businesses. The loading bay will be in operation between 7am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive. To assist drivers manoeuvring into and out of the loading bay waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" will be introduced on the approach to and exit from the lay-by.

A separate order introduces three free limited-time parking bays in Stanley Road, Teddington.

The three proposed orders whose titles are given above will make the necessary provisions for the enforcement of the restrictions as described.
