1. Welcome by chair and apologies for absence

Angela Style welcomed everyone and confirmed no members of the public were present. Apologies were noted.

2. Minutes of the last Meeting:

3. Chairs Report

AS told the Committee of a PLG Chair's meeting with the Borough Commander, Clive Chalk which took place on 22nd June.

AS told the members that Sgt. Dave George the new A/Insp. gave a talk on the work his team has undertaken with regards to licensing. In some cases offences had been reduced from 40 to 1. The information on licences is now on line.

He also noted there has been a flexing of resources within SNT personnel with positive effects. However it was stressed that no ward had been left without cover.

All local recommendations of the SNT review had been forwarded to MPA

Various proposals were put forward re staffing which do not affect all Borough wards.

AS stated she has been kept informed regarding the attempted child abduction and towpath grabbing's. AS told the members that she was called to a meeting with the Borough Commander to discuss the ramification of one of the incidents

and the attendants were also given the opportunity to discuss how these matters could be dealt in a more co-ordinated and better manner in the future.

AS stated that at the next meeting on 15th September the Borough Commander would be present having accepted our invitation to attend, she added that it would be her last as Chair. AS said she was pleased to announce that Wendy Kyrle-Pope has agreed to take the role of Chair from November, when next year's meetings will also be announced.
