

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)

**Temporary waiting and loading restrictions
Strawberry Vale, Twickenham
17 and 26 September 2012**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to enable a crane to stand on the highway in connection with the ongoing works at the adjacent site they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce waiting and loading restrictions in Strawberry Vale, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait or load in Strawberry Vale from its junction with the southern arm of Mickleham Gardens to the common boundary of Nos 50 and 52 Strawberry Vale.
3. The order will come into effect on 17 September 2012. It is anticipated that the crane will be deployed on that day and on 26 September. However, the order will remain in force for a period of 1 month, to allow for unexpected events and possible rescheduling of the works.
4. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
