REVIEW OF PARKING CHARGES 2009

**DIFFERENTIAL PARKING CHARGES AT OFF-STREET CAR PARKS AND
AT ON-STREET PAY AND DISPLAY BAYS**

TEDDINGTON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL CAR PARK
(Reference 44/09)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 7 August 2009 made the above Orders under sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The principal objective of the orders is to encourage owners and drivers to consider their choice of vehicle, and to encourage the use of low-emission vehicles which have less harmful effect on the environment than vehicles which emit higher quantities of exhaust gases. The **off-street parking places consolidation order** makes provisions for off-street car parks, and the **charges and payment of parking charges order** makes corresponding provisions for on-street pay and display parking bays.
3. The general effect of the orders is to:-
 - (i) make a general increase for off-street and on-street parking charges to be known as the standard parking charge tier – see paragraph 4;
 - (ii) to give drivers of vehicles which meet certain criteria (measured by CO₂ emissions or size of engine) the opportunity to pay a discounted parking charge, which may be either a medium or a low parking charge tier – see paragraph 4;
 - (iii) introduce a Richmond Card which may be used to pay parking charges, whether discounted or not – see schedule 5;
 - (iv) vary the parking charges at Cedar Road, North Lane (east), North Lane (west) and Teddington pools and gym off-street car parks, Teddington, such that, having taken into account the general increase referred to in (i) above, the standard parking charge tier at each of these sites is set at the common rate of £0.50 per 30 minutes and which is subject to the same discounted charges as indicated in (ii) above;
 - (v) give the Council powers to introduce, vary and withdraw special, or concessionary, parking charges for off-street and on-street parking – see paragraph 7 and Schedule 7.
4. The general increase in parking charges and the two levels of discounted charges (all of which are referred to in this notice as “differential charges”) are in accordance with the following table:

“Older vehicles” means those first registered before 1 March 2001, and “newer vehicles” are those first registered on or after that date.

The words “standard”, “medium” and “low” are used in this notice to denote the three levels of differential parking charges which will apply to any one car park or parking place according to the vehicle using it. These are equivalent to the terms “Tier 3”, “Tier 2” and “Tier 1” respectively which were used in the notice of proposals published on 5 June 2009 and which are the terms used in the orders.

The “standard” and “low” charges (other than for season tickets) will be rounded up or down to the next 5 pence value, and this tariff will apply whatever method of payment is used (cash, credit/debit card, Richmond Card or payment by mobile telephone).

The “medium” and “low” parking charges may only be paid by drivers who pre-register their vehicles and apply for, are issued with and use a Richmond Card or who pay the parking charge by using the mobile telephone payment system already in use within the borough.

5. The table in paragraph 4 above specifies for the “medium” parking charge a range of CO₂ emissions between 121 and 185 g/km, whereas the proposals published on 5 June 2009 specified this range as being between 121 and 180 g/km. The effect of this change is that newer vehicles with emissions in the range 181-185 g/km will now qualify for the “medium” tier of parking charges.
6. The standard charge which will apply in each car park and on-street pay and display bay are specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3. Schedule 4 tabulates the standard charge together with the corresponding medium and low charges. The medium charge is the same as the parking charges currently in force. As stated in paragraph 4 above, the medium charges are the same as the charges currently in force, and which will continue until 1 October 2009.
7. A charge of £2.50 will be made for the issue of a Richmond Card (but see Schedules 5 and 6).
8. The orders make provision for the measures indicated in paragraph 3 above to be implemented in stages - see Schedule 6.
9. The orders give the Council powers to announce special parking charges from time to time to assist local businesses, and these may be introduced, varied or terminated by giving 21 days public notice. The Council hereby gives notice that special parking

- charges will be introduced contemporaneously with the introduction of differential parking charges - see Schedule 7.
10. The Council has deferred making a decision in respect of the proposal to introduce charges at the Teddington Memorial Hospital car park, notice of which was given on 5 June 2009.
 11. The **off-street parking places consolidation order** makes minor variations to existing tariffs, in cases where the current order stipulates hourly parking periods but where ticket machines are able to issue tickets for half-hourly periods, and consolidates into one order the provisions of the current off-street parking places order, as amended.
 12. The provisions as to the telephone payment parking system for on-street parking (which were introduced by order made in February 2009) are included in the **charges and payment of parking charges parking places order**. The order which was made in February will be revoked on the day this order comes into force.
 13. A separate notice is being published this day in respect of a variation in the cost of parking vouchers. The **charges and payment of parking charges order** includes that variation in its provisions in respect of the 7 zones in the borough where vouchers may be used.
 14. Further particulars are given in the Schedules to this notice. Schedule 1 sets out the "standard" charges at pay and display car parks. Schedule 2 sets out "standard" charges at pay-on-foot car parks. Both schedules include "standard" charges for season tickets where these are available. Schedule 3 sets out the "standard" on-street charges. Schedule 4 tabulates the discounted "medium" and "low" parking charges which will apply to every "standard" charge throughout the borough, as previously stated. Schedule 5 gives the principal features of the Richmond Card scheme. Schedule 6 sets out the timetable within which the Council will implement the changes. Schedule 7 gives details of the special charges.
 15. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation in stages with effect from 17 August 2009 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 44/09, at:-
 - (a) every branch library in the borough (other than Richmond Lending Library) during opening hours; and
 - (b) the Civic Centre (Planning Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.
 16. Copies of these Orders may be purchased from the Environment Directorate, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.
 17. Persons wishing to question the validity of these Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 5

Use of the Richmond Card

- 1 Any person (whether or not resident or working in Richmond upon Thames) may apply for a Richmond Card, and must supply such details as the Council may require for the vehicle to be registered and the correct tier for parking charges to be encoded on the card. Owners of vehicles which fall into the standard parking charge tier (and do not qualify for a medium or low discounted parking charge) are eligible to apply for a Richmond Card.
- 2 The Richmond Card may also be used to pay for parking charges. The Council will provide a number of ways for card-holders to acquire a credit balance on the card (although such methods are not prescribed by the orders).
- 3 On using a pay and display machine (either at a "pay and display" off-street car park or at on-street parking bay), if the driver inserts the Richmond Card in the ticket machine the machine will select the appropriate tariff and the driver may pay the parking charge using coins, by credit or debit card or by using the Richmond Card (the machine will deduct the correct amount from the credit balance). The parking ticket will include the registration number of the vehicle encoded on the card, and it will be a contravention to display a ticket with any registration number printed thereon other than that of the vehicle parked in the parking place. Without the card, the standard tariff will apply, no registration number will be involved, and no subsequent claim may be made against the Council for a discounted charge.
- 4 The use of a Richmond Card at "pay on foot" off-street car parks (specified in Schedule 2) will be dependent on the equipment used at these locations.
- 5 If the Council has reason to believe that a Richmond Card has been deliberately or fraudulently misused it may disable or withdraw that card. Lost cards may be

replaced on payment of an administration charge of £10, and any credit which remained on the card at the time when it was reported lost will be added to the replacement card.

SCHEDULE 6

Timetable to implement the measures

- STEP 1 APPLICATION FOR A RICHMOND CARD ISSUED FREE OF CHARGE**
The relevant part of the Orders will come into force on Monday 17 August 2009. Applications may be made for a Richmond Card, and the Council will, subject to a satisfactory application, issue it free of charge. The Council will, until the Step 3 date, issue only one card to any one person free of charge, and the administration charge for a replacement card will be levied in all cases.
- STEP 2 NEW TARIFFS AT TEDDINGTON CAR PARKS and INTRODUCTION OF DIFFERENTIAL PARKING CHARGES, STAGE 1**
The relevant part of the Orders will come into force on Thursday 1 October 2009. On that day, the differential parking charges as tabulated in Schedule 4 will come into force in respect of following:-
- (i) the "pay and display" off-street cars parks specified in Schedule 1; and
 - (ii) all on-street "pay and display" parking bays in areas specified in Schedule 3.
- STEP 3 CHARGES FOR A RICHMOND CARD**
The relevant part of the Orders will come into force on Monday 2 November 2009. With effect from that day, the Council will levy the charge for the issue of a Richmond Card (being £2.50, see paragraph 7 of the Notice). Any person whose application for a Richmond Card is received by the Council on or after this date will be required to pay the charge before the card is issued. The deadline for receipt of an application for a free Richmond Card will be 4.30pm on Friday 30 October 2009.
- STEP 4 INTRODUCTION OF DIFFERENTIAL PARKING CHARGES, STAGE 2**
On or after the Step 2 date the differential parking charges tabulated in Schedule 4 will come into force at the "pay on foot" off-street car parks specified in Schedule 2. The Council will give at least 21 days public notice of the date when this step will come into force – see Note 1.

NOTES TO SCHEDULE 6

- 1 The public notice referred to in Step 4 will be published at least once in a newspaper circulating in the borough.
- 2 The Council will arrange for such other publicity as it sees fit.

SCHEDULE 7

Special parking charges

- 1 The orders make provision that special, or concessionary, parking charges may be introduced, varied and terminated by giving at least 21 days notice of such introduction, variation or termination.
- 2 The Council hereby gives notice that the special charges specified below will be introduced with effect from 1 October 2009.

OFF-STREET "PAY AND DISPLAY" CAR PARKS

The special parking charge set out in the following table will apply to all off-street car parks specified in Schedule 1 to this notice (other than the car park at the Kew Gardens station

forecourt) and is in respect of vehicles which enter any such car park at or after 3.00pm and before 6.30pm on any Thursday. Any maximum stay which is otherwise in force for periods of 1, 2 or 3 hours will be waived for the remainder of that day. Drivers may park for shorter periods, in accordance with the tariffs given elsewhere in this notice, and the charge for such periods will in all cases be less than or equal to the maximum charge as specified here.

This tariff is not available to drivers who enter any off-street car park before 3pm on a Thursday. This tariff does not apply to those car parks which do not operate on Thursdays.

ON-STREET "PAY AND DISPLAY" BAYS

The special parking charge set out in the following table will apply to all on-street pay and display bays (except Upper Teddington Road, Hampton Wick where parking periods are paid for in hourly intervals). This special parking charge applies also to the car park at the Kew Gardens station forecourt. This concession will apply only at the time of arrival.

This tariff applies only to parking periods of 20 minutes or less.
