- Emergency contraception** (can be taken up to 72 hours after unprotected sexual intercourse) is available at Teddington **NHS Walk-In Centre** based at Teddington Memorial Hospital, Hampton Road, Teddington open Mon-Fri 8.00am-10.00 pm and Sat, Sun and bank holidays 8.00am-9.00pm. Emergency contraception is available from all of the above services and may also be purchased at chemists. (for young people aged 13 years and over)
- Abortion referrals** can be made from **all services** to West Middlesex University Hospital and BPAS
