East Sheen controlled parking zone (CPZ) – Review

In July 2008, the Council consulted residents and businesses within the existing East Sheen controlled parking zone (see orange shaded area on map overleaf) and in the Elm Road area west of the existing CPZ (see yellow shaded area on map overleaf) on two proposals as follows:

1. To reduce the operational hours of the CPZ from 10am - 4.30pm, Monday to Friday, to 11am - 1pm, Monday to Friday.
2. To extend the CPZ into the Elm Road area.

The results of the consultation showed insufficient support for these two proposals. These results were reported to the Transport Consultative Group (TCG) in September 2008. The Cabinet Member for Traffic, Transport and Parking approved the recommendation not to proceed with the reduction in hours of control or to extend the zone.

However, the Cabinet Member approved the following actions:

Proposal 1

Because of the number of representations made for improvements in parking provision in the CPZ for businesses and visitors, the Council was asked to consider a proposal for additional parking provision for these groups. Proposals were developed and put forward to the TCG in December 2008. The Cabinet Member approved the proposals which are to provide an additional 33 shared-use parking areas (permit holder / pay and display, maximum 4 hours) in the CPZ. This will go through consultation with the second proposal below.

- Enclosed is the plan which shows the proposals for the new shared-use bays.

Proposal 2

The TCG approved the implementation of no waiting “at any time” restrictions (double yellow lines) because of the safety concerns at junctions in the Elm Road / Leinster Avenue area.

- Enclosed is a plan showing the proposals for no waiting “at any time” restrictions in the Elm Road / Leinster Avenue area.

Both proposals 1 and 2 will go through the following consultation process:

Formal advertisement by way of traffic management orders on **Friday 1 May 2009** which provides you with the opportunity to make representations. Representations must be received on or by **Tuesday 26 May 2009**.

The plans will be on display from 5 May at the Sheen Lane Centre, Sheen Lane, East Sheen, and on the Council website www.richmond.gov.uk/eastsheen_cpz_consultation. You can make your representations by letter or email to the Head of Highways and Transport, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham, TW1 3BZ or by e-mail to highwaysandtransport@richmond.gov.uk.

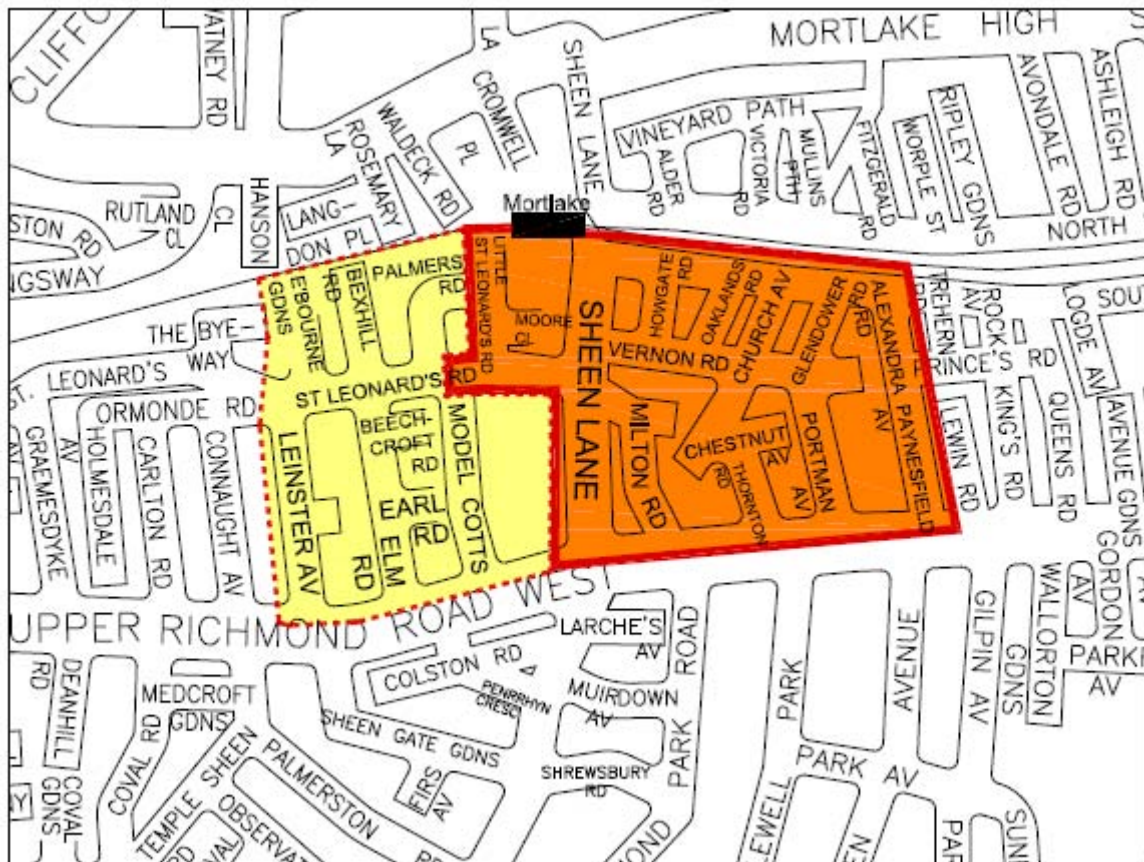
