What is the Register of Electors?

The Register of Electors (sometimes called the electoral register or roll) is the list of everyone who is registered to vote. You must be on the register to vote in elections and referendums. You are NOT automatically registered, even if you pay Council Tax.

You can register to vote at any time. If you are not registered at your current address, for example if you have moved home, you will need to fill in a registration form.

Who has my personal details?

There are two versions of the register - the full version and the edited version. Your details will appear on the full version of the register, but you can choose whether or not your details appear on the edited register.

The full register is used for elections and referendums, preventing and detecting crime, and checking applications for credit. The edited register is available for general sale and can be used for commercial activities such as marketing.

In accordance with the Representation of the People Acts, any application to be registered as an elector is subject to public inspection to allow for objection to the application to be made. At the end of this period of public inspection (if no objection has been received) the applicant may be added to the register of Electors. Please note that you can register up to 11 days before an election, although you should return your form immediately so that you do not miss an election deadline.
