Dear Owner / Occupier

**St Margarets South controlled parking zone extension (CPZ, Zone S)**

I am writing to advise you that the St Margarets South CPZ is to be extended to Bridge Road and Winchester Road. The extension will be implemented by Friday 17 October 2008, weather permitting. The zone will operate **10am to 4.30pm, Monday to Friday**.

Parking areas will be designated in the CPZ for resident permit holders, business permit holders, and visitors (Pay & Display / parking voucher). If you park your vehicle(s) in the CPZ during the hours of operation, you will need to display a valid parking permit.

**The zone will come into operation from Monday 20 October 2008 although full enforcement will not commence until Monday 3 November 2008. During the period Monday 20 October to Friday 31 October warning notices will be issued to illegally parked vehicles.**

Residents can apply for resident permits for their vehicle(s) and resident visitor permits for their visitors' vehicles. These permits will be valid in the following areas:

- "Resident Permit Holders Only" parking areas
- "Permit Holders Only" parking areas (Resident/Business Permit Holders)
- "Resident / Business / Visitor (pay and display / parking voucher)" parking areas

All resident permits obtained as of October will be dated from 1 November 2008 **but will be valid for use** from 20 October 2008.

Where parking areas are not designated within the zone, yellow lines (waiting restrictions) will be in place. These comprise single and double yellow lines. No waiting will be permitted on the double yellow lines at any time. No waiting will be permitted on the single yellow lines between 10am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday, unless otherwise indicated by signs on the footway.

As explained in the consultation document, the Council has continued the parking areas across dropped kerbs in front of driveways to individual residential properties. This enables the residents of these properties or any of their visitors to park in front of the driveway. Please note that to park in any parking areas in front of dropped kerbs requires permission from the owners / occupiers of those properties. If requiring to park in these areas during the controlled hours a valid parking permit is required to be on display.

Please find enclosed the following:

- Two resident permit application forms, guidance notes and additional notes on parking charges

- One resident visitor application form and guidance notes
- A map showing the layout of parking areas and boundary of the St Margarets South CPZ

From Monday 3 November 2008 any parking contraventions will result in the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice. Up until then only warning notices will be affixed to vehicles and no further action taken.

The purpose of the CPZ extension is to improve parking conditions for residents and businesses in the St Margarets area. The decision to extend the zone was made following consideration of the results of the recent consultation exercise which comprised returned questionnaires, comments and representations. If you took part in the consultation, I would like to thank you for taking the time to make your views known to the Council.

The Council will review the CPZ extension after approximately six months of operation.
