

Proposed closure of Hampton Community College (to be re-opened as an academy)

Notice is given in accordance with section 15(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, Regal House, London Road, Twickenham, TW1 3QB, intends to discontinue Hampton Community College, Hanworth Road, Hampton, TW12 3HB, on 31 August 2010.

It is planned that the school will re-open as an academy on 1 September 2010.

The pupils in Years 7-10 inclusive as at 31 August 2010 will automatically transfer to the academy on 1 September 2010.

Pupil in the attached unit (Richmond House) for statemented young people with behavioural and emotional difficulties, which is currently managed by Hampton Community College, will remain in Richmond House, but its management will pass to the control of the local special school provision. The pupils currently attending Richmond House will, as appropriate, continue to receive home to school transport as part of their statements of special educational needs.
