TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 45) ORDER 2010

Made: 13 September 2010

Coming into operation: 27 September 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 27 September 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 45) Order 2010.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the items numbered 339, 517, 608, 628, 633 and 739 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 2 to that Order the item numbered 30A and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces makes a number of changes to the waiting and loading restrictions in High Street and Upper Teddington Road, Hampton Wick, and in some of the local side streets. These streets are all within the area of the Hampton Wick controlled parking zone.

Waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" are introduced as follows:-

- (1) At the roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge, Hampton Court Road and High Street, Hampton Wick;
- (2) on the west side of High Street, from outside No 21 High Street to its junction with Upper Teddington Road (in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, zig-zag lines at pedestrian crossings, bus stop clearways and other than at the junction of High Street with School Road);
- on the east side of High Street, from the roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge to its junction with Upper Teddington Road (in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, zig-zag lines at pedestrian crossings or bus stop clearways);
- on both sides of Park Road, between its junctions with High Street and St Johns Road (in place of an existing single yellow line);
- on both sides of St Johns Road, at its junction with Park Road for 5 metres from Park Road (in place of an existing single yellow line);
- (6) on both sides of Seymour Road, from its junction with High Street to the first of the designated parking bays (distances of approximately 15 metres from High Street on the east side and 35 metres from High Street on the west side in place of an existing single yellow line);
- (7) on both sides of Vicarage Road, from its junction with High Street to the first of the designated parking bays (distances of approximately 20 metres from High Street on the north side and 40 metres from High Street on the south side in place of an existing single yellow line).

Loading restrictions "no loading at any time" are introduced as follows:-

- (1) At the roundabout at the junction of High Street, the western end of Kingston Bridge and Hampton Court Road;
- (2) For a distance of 20 metres on the west side of High Street outside Nos 21-25 High Street.

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 8 September 2010 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the **Hampton Wick Parking Places Amendment Order** is to make various changes and additions to the designated parking bays in High Street, St Johns Road, Upper Teddington Road and Vicarage Road as specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice. Some of the proposals in respect of which the Council gave notice on 26 February 2010 have been withdrawn, and particulars of such variations from the proposed scheme are given in Schedule 1.
- 3. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to make various changes and additions to the waiting and loading restrictions in High Street, Park Road, St Johns Road, School Road, Seymour Road, Upper Teddington Road and Vicarage Road as specified in Schedule 2 (waiting restrictions) and Schedule 3 (loading restrictions) to this Notice. Some of the proposals in respect of which the Council gave notice on 26 February 2010 have been withdrawn, and particulars of such variations from the proposed scheme are given in Schedule 2.
- 4. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 20 September 2010, a plan showing the location and effect of the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders:-
 - (a) can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 65/10, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

- 6. Persons wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

Designated Parking Bays – Hampton Wick controlled parking zone Operating between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive

(1) High Street:

- (a) west side, outside Nos 5-7 High Street:- THE PROPOSAL to introduce a permit holder's bay HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN – (see Note 1);
- (b) west side, outside Nos 9-21 High Street:- THE PROPOSAL to remove 3 bays from the existing line of 8 pay and display parking bays and replace with a single yellow line HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN AND IN ITS PLACE 4 PAY AND DISPLAY BAYS ARE TO BE INTRODUCED AS AN EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME, NOTICE OF WHICH IS GIVEN SEPARATELY (see Schedule 2, item (2));
- (c) west side, outside Nos 59-63 High Street:- discontinue the two existing pay and display parking bays outside Nos 61 and 63 High Street and re-introduce two similar bays approximately 10 metres to the south, outside Nos 59-61 High Street (the "Sanyo restaurant") (see Note 2);
- (d) west side, outside Nos 65-73 High Street:- THE PROPOSAL TO EXTEND the resident permit holder's parking bay HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN;
- (e) east side, outside "The Swan" public house and No 26 High Street:- introduce 3 pay and display parking bays (see Note 2);
- (f) east side, outside Nos 56-60 High Street:- THE PROPOSAL TO introduce a permit holder's bay HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN;
- (2) St Johns Road, north-west side:- shorten by a length of 2 metres the existing resident permit holder's bay closest to Park Road.
- (3) Upper Teddington Road, south-west side and outside the RPJ Autos garage (that is, between the railway bridge and the Hampton Wick Surgery):- introduce 3 shared-use pay and display and permit holder parking bays (see Note 3).
- (4) Vicarage Road, north-east side, opposite Nos 1-15 Vicarage Road:- alter the existing pay and display parking bays such that they become shared-use pay and display and residents' permit holder bays (see Note 4).

Notes to Schedule 1

- 1 Not used.
- The standard pay and display parking charges at the bays referred to in items (1)(c) and (1)(e) are in accordance with the Hampton Wick inner area tariff. Vehicles displaying a valid ticket may be left in these bays for a maximum of 1 hour. Residents' permits are valid in these bays between 8.30 and 9.30am and between 5.30 and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays..
- The standard pay and display parking charges at the proposed shared-use bays referred to in item (3) are in accordance with the Hampton Wick inner area tariff. Vehicles displaying a valid ticket may be left in these bays for a maximum of 1 hour, or, if they display a valid resident's permit or a business permit valid for the inner area of this zone, without time limit.

- In respect of the shared-use bays referred to in item (4), the standard pay and display parking charges are in accordance with the Hampton Wick inner area tariff. Vehicles displaying a valid ticket or a valid resident's permit may be left in these bays for a maximum of 10 hours. The number of parking bays is given in the order as 15 bays which is a correction to the number (14) indicated in the proposed order.
- The standard charge for the Hampton Wick inner area tariff is £0.25 per 12 minutes or £1.25/hour. Discounted charges are available if payment is made using the mobile telephone payment system or by using a pre-payment RichmondCard. Discounted parking charges will apply to vehicles which have been pre-registered on either of these systems and which meet the current emissions-based criteria.

Waiting restrictions

All single yellow lines referred to in this schedule indicate "no waiting between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" unless otherwise stated

- (1) The roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge, Hampton Court Road and High Street, Hampton Wick:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (see also Schedule 3, item (1)).
- (2) High Street, west side, outside Nos 13 17 High Street:- THE PROPOSAL TO introduce a single yellow line with the restrictions as indicated above HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN, AND IN ITS PLACE A SINGLE YELLOW LINE WITH OTHER HOURS OF CONTROL IS TO BE INTRODUCED AS AN EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME, NOTICE OF WHICH IS GIVEN SEPARATELY.
- (3) High Street, west side, from outside No 21 High Street to its junction with Upper Teddington Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, controlled areas (zig-zag lines) at pedestrian crossings or bus stop clearways AND EXCEPT AS STATED IN PARAGRAPH (a) BELOW (see also Schedule 3, item (2)):-
 - (a) THE PROPOSAL TO INTRODUCE DOUBLE YELLOW LINES AT THE JUNCTION OF HIGH STREET WITH SCHOOL ROAD HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN.
- (4) High Street, east side, from the roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge to its junction with Upper Teddington Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, controlled areas (zig-zag lines) at pedestrian crossings or bus stop clearways.
- (5) Park Road, both sides, between its junctions with High Street and St Johns Road:introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (6) Park Road, north side, at its junction with School Road:- THE PROPOSAL to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN.
- (7) St Johns Road, both sides, at its junction with Park Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for 5 metres from Park Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.

- (8) School Road, both sides:- THE PROPOSAL to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN.
- (9) Seymour Road, both sides at its junction with High Street:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for 15 metres from High Street on the east side of Seymour Road and for 35 metres from High Street on the west side of Seymour Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (10) Vicarage Road, both sides at its junction with High Street:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for approximately 20 metres from High Street on the north side of Vicarage Road and for approximately 40 metres from High Street on the south side of Vicarage Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.

- (3) High Street, west side, from outside No 21 High Street to its junction with Upper Teddington Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, controlled areas (zig-zag lines) at pedestrian crossings or bus stop clearways (see also Schedule 2, item (2)).
- (4) High Street, east side, from the roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge to its junction with Upper Teddington Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays, controlled areas (zig-zag lines) at pedestrian crossings or bus stop clearways.
- (5) Park Road, both sides, between its junctions with High Street and St Johns Road:introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (6) Park Road, north side, at its junction with School Road and on the east side of that junction:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for 10 metres from School Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (7) St Johns Road, both sides, at its junction with Park Road:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for 5 metres from Park Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (8) School Road, both sides:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in place of an existing single yellow line, other than where there are designated parking bays.
- (9) Seymour Road, both sides at its junction with High Street:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for 15 metres from High Street on the east side of Seymour Road and for 35 metres from High Street on the west side of Seymour Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.
- (10) Vicarage Road, both sides at its junction with High Street:- introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" (for approximately 20 metres from High Street on the north side of Vicarage Road and for approximately 40 metres from High Street on the south side of Vicarage Road) in place of an existing single yellow line.

Note to Schedule 1

The length of street referred to in item (2) above on the west side of High Street outside Nos 13-17 High Street is currently in use as 3 pay and display parking bays – the proposals for changes and additions to the designated parking bays include the removal of these bays and for 3 similar bays to be provided on the east side of High Street.

Loading restrictions

- (1) The roundabout at the junction of Kingston Bridge, Hampton Court Road and High Street, Hampton Wick:- introduce loading restrictions "no loading at any time".
- (2) High Street, the west side, outside Nos 21-25 High Street:- introduce loading restrictions "no loading at any time" for a length of 20 metres.
