The festival involves local partners including the Environment Trust for Richmond, London's Arcadia and the Thames Landscape Strategy, Museum of Richmond, Hampton Community College, as well as a number of contemporary artists. The festival will involve the whole community, including young people from the borough, taking part and celebrating what makes Richmond upon Thames special.
