# TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

# THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 61) ORDER 2010

Made: 13 December 2010

Coming into operation: 20 December 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 December 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 61) Order 2010.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
  - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
  - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(b)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) for the items numbered 355 and 597 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and as set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
  - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the items numbered 111A and 600B and as set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" as follows:-

#### **Cedar Avenue, Whitton:**

Both sides, from its junction with Hounslow Road for a distance of 10 metres.

#### **Hounslow Road, Whitton:**

The north-east side, at its junction with Cedar Road, for a distance of 6 metres to the south-east of the junction, outside No 128 Hounslow Road, and for a distance of 7 metres to the north-west of the junction, outside No 130 Hounslow Road.

The proposals, notice of which was given on 19 March 2010, in respect of restrictions on the south-west side of Hounslow Road have been withdrawn, and in respect of restrictions on the north-east side of Hounslow Road have been modified as indicated in the previous paragraph.

#### Runnymede Road, Whitton:

The north-west and west sides, extend the existing double yellow lines at its junction with Hounslow Road to a point 5 metres south of Rydal Gardens, and extending into the service road serving Nos 2-14 Runnymede Road to a point outside No 12 Runnymede Road.

The south-east and east sides, extend the existing double yellow lines at its junction with Hounslow Road to a point opposite the southern kerb-line of Rydal Gardens.

The proposals, notice of which was given on 19 March 2010, in respect of restrictions on the east side Runnymede Road have been modified as indicated in the previous paragraph.

#### Rydal Gardens, Whitton:

Both sides, from its junction with Runnymede Road for distances of 6.6 metres on the north side and for 5.7 metres on the south side.

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FR PROPOSING TO MAKE THIS ORDER

The Council receives reports from time to time on matters of road safety caused by parked vehicles and may come from residents, Councillors or bus and emergency services. These matters include poor sight lines at junctions, obstruction of footway crossing points, lack of suitable passing areas and reduced carriageway width restricting or preventing access for vehicles especially emergency service vehicles.

This Order is intended to improve road safety for all users by introducing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" at the locations listed in the Explanatory Note Similar restrictions have proved effective in locations elsewhere in the borough that previously suffered similar problems.

## CEDAR ROAD, WHITTON HOUNSLOW ROAD, WHITTON RUNNYMEDE ROAD, WHITTON RYDAL GARDENS, WHITTON

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 13 December 2010 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" in the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- 3. This Order brings into operation the remainder of the restrictions of which the Council first gave notice on 5 March 2010. The Order specified in Schedule 2 to this notice has previously been made by the Council and brought into operation the proposal in respect of waiting restrictions at the south-eastern end of Elmsleigh Road, Twickenham.

The south-east and east sides, extend the existing double yellow lines at its junction with Hounslow Road to a point opposite the southern kerb-line of Rydal Gardens.

The proposals, notice of which was given on 19 March 2010, in respect of restrictions on the east side Runnymede Road have been modified as indicated in the previous paragraph.

### **Rydal Gardens, Whitton:**

Both sides, from its junction with Runnymede Road for distances of 6.6 metres on the north side and for 5.7 metres on the south side.

Both sides, from its junction with Hounslow Road for a distance of 10 metres.
