St Margarets South controlled parking zone (CPZ) extension

Following consultation with residents and businesses of the uncontrolled roads adjacent to the St Margarets South controlled parking zone, the Cabinet Member for Traffic, Transport and Parking approved the formal advertisement of proposals to extend the St Margarets South CPZ to Moor Mead Road and Sidney Road and to include all properties of The Grove and Cole Park View for eligibility of parking permits. The St Margarets South CPZ (zone S) operates Monday to Friday, 10am to 4.30pm.

In addition the Council are giving residents of Kenley Road and Godstone Road an opportunity to reconsider their position in the light of this further extension to the CPZ.

These proposals are being formally advertised by way of traffic management orders on **Friday 2 October 2009**. The plans will be on display from this date at the Twickenham Library, Garfield Road, Twickenham and at the Council offices, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham during opening hours. The plans will also be available for inspection on the Council's website http://www.richmond.gov.uk/sidney_and_moor_mead_roads_cpz_extension from **Friday 2 October 2009**.

Representations are invited by letter to the Head of Highways and Transport, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham, TW1 3BZ or by email to highwaysandtransport@richmond.gov.uk to be received on or by **Friday 23 October 2009**. These will be reported to the Cabinet Member, following which further information will be posted to all affected properties advising of scheduled implementation and how to apply for parking permits.

One aspect of the scheme involves continuing parking across dropped kerbs in order to maximise parking spaces. Where such dropped kerbs serve a driveway

or garage, parking should only take place by the residents of that property and their visitors, displaying a valid parking permit during the CPZ operational hours.

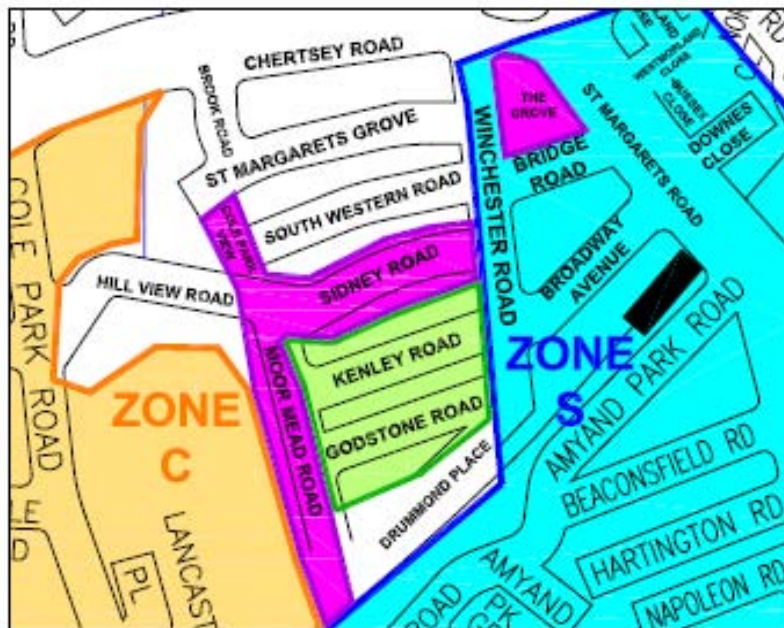
