**Sunday 18 Sept**

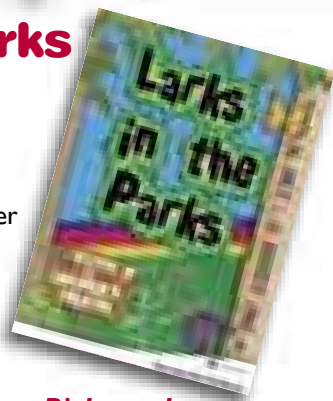
