- Offering a universal standard across our services for people living with dementia and their unpaid carers
- To receive care for dementia at the same time as their physical needs
- Aiming for positive interactions and well being



Dementia Clinical Specialist Role for community



- Teaching / supporting staff across HRCH, volunteers, GP practice, care homes
- Assisting staff to case find and confirm diagnosis
- Supporting carers and patients
- Referring / signposting into other local voluntary and statutory services
- Liaising with GP's, patients and families to assist in anticipatory care planning
- To work proactively with patients and carers in order to reduce the risk of a crisis developing
 - Preventing unnecessary hospital admission
 - Facilitate self management
 - Anticipatory care planning

Dementia Clinical Specialist Role for HRCH



- Develop holistic assessment tool to include quality of life
- Ensure introduction of tool across HRCH services
- Carers support pathway
- Review TMH environment and other buildings to be dementia friendly
- Look for gaps mild cognitive impairment, volunteers to help with ward activities, what else needed?
