# THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (COLE PARK) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 1999

Made 29<sup>th</sup> September 1999

Coming into operation 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1999

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991(b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1999 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Cole Park) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1999.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Cole Park) (Parking Places) Order 1994(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) there were added to Schedule 5 to that Order the items numbered 5/35 and 5/36 as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order; and
  - (b) there was added to Schedule 7 to that Order the following:-

15. Erncroft Way.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS', RESIDENTS' VISITORS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.

# THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES COLE PARK (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 1999

### STATEMENT OF REASONS

At its meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> January 1999 the Council's Transport Sub Committee considered the results of the consultations on the proposed match/event day controlled parking zones around the RFU ground in Rugby Road, Twickenham.

It was agreed that the extension of the existing Cole Park Controlled Parking Zone that operates between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Fridays be advertised to include Erncroft Way.

### THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (A) TWICKENHAM STADIUM EVENT DAYS (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1999. (B) TWICKENHAM STADIUM EVENT DAYS (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 1999.

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, with the consent of the London Borough of Hounslow by an agreement made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, on the 29th September 1999 made the above Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The effects of the Orders are:-

(A) to introduce parking places to the streets listed in Part I of the Schedule to this Notice for the use of residents', residents' visitors and business vehicles displaying the relevant parking permits, operational between 7am and 9pm, on those days when major events are held at the RFC Ground, Rugby Road, Twickenham and when the relevant signs are displayed. The permits are issued free of charge.

(B) to introduce waiting restrictions, operational between 7am and 9pm on event days, to those lengths of streets listed in Part I and Part II of the Schedule to this Notice that are not designated as

parking places.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 29th September 1999 made the above Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The effects of the Orders are:

(A) the extend the existing Cole Park Controlled Parking Zone, operational between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Fridays,

to include ERNCROFT WAY;
(B) to introduce waiting restrictions operational between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Fridays to those lengths of Emcroft Way not covered by existing waiting restrictions or parking

The parking charges relating to the extended Zone are as fol-

(a) residents' parking permits - £114 for a permit valid for a period of 24 months, £60 for 12 months, £36 for 6 months and £21 for

(b) residents' visitors' parking permits - £9 for a book of 12 permits or £4.50 for a book for residents aged 60 years or over.
