(COLE PARK) (PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 1996

Made 22nd January 1996

Coming into operation 29th January 1996

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 29th January 1996 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Cole Park) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1996.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Cole Park) (Parking Places) Order 1994 (c) shall have effect as though for the item numbered 5/28 of Schedule 5 to that Order there was substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order.

THE SCHEDULE

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 8.30 AM AND 6.30 PM ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS', RESIDENTS' VISITORS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.
