

LONDON LOCAL AUTHORITIES ACT 1996 PART III – OCCASIONAL SALES

GUIDANCE NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

1. LICENCE REQUIREMENT

The type of sales that need licences are:

Commercial Sales with 5 or more stall/pitches, not held on the highway (ie. a street trading site) and not held in a building other than a car park.

No licence is needed for those markets/sales having existing planning consent, statutory grant, or established before 1 July 1948.

No licence is needed for sales whose proceeds are solely or principally for charitable, social, sporting, religious or political purposes.

2. APPLICATIONS

- (i) must be made on the Council's application form
- (ii) must be accompanied by the Council's fee of £
- (iii) must be made NOT LESS THAN 42 DAYS before the event.

3. PLAN SUBMISSION/NOISE CONTROL ARRANGEMENTS

To assist the Council to fully consider the application, detailed scale plans accompany the application showing:

- layouts of stalls/pitches
- layout of parking areas
- arrangements for controlling traffic congestion
- arrangements for controlling litter (bin and skip positions)

plus details of proposed noise control arrangements.

4. OBJECTIONS AND OPPOSITION

Various bodies will be consulted including Ward Councillors, Police, LFCDA and the Council's Highways, Planning, Environmental Services and Pollution Departments.

If no objections are forthcoming the licence will be granted subject to the Council's conditions.
