Aim and who can apply :

This new level 3 certificate provides the opportunity for specific & relevant continuous professional development for workers to develop knowledge and skills in the provision of care and support to individuals in a Learning Disability setting to provide high quality person centred support. It is suitable for those who are working in a learning disability service or supporting people with learning disabilities as part of their work role. This qualification is also suitable to individuals who may already have an NVQ to enable them to gain a shorter CPD qualification. The LD Certificate consists of achieving (23 credits) 6 units – 3 are mandatory and workshops will be provided for these units.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the programme candidates will have completed the following 6 units with the relevant skills and knowledge:

- Understand the context of supporting people with learning disabilities
- Support person centred thinking
- Promote Communication in health & Social Care Settings
- Support people in their relationships.
- Provide support to maintain and develop skills for everyday life.
- Provide support to maintain & develop risk taking for individuals
- 2 observations will be planned by a qualified assessor for those units that require competence to be demonstrated for 5 units

Candidates will be required to attend all 3 workshops to gain the underpinning knowledge. Each candidate will also be observed and assessed in their workplace.
