### **Item 1 / 11 Crimes and Disorder**

An update on the crimes was provided by Neil Henson PS 36TW. The problem of burglaries was outlined. We discussed the Anti Social Behaviour taking place, especially the graffiti in Carlisle Park. We also went through the work to prevent Hampton properties being used as Cannabis factories.

### **Item 2 / 11 Review of the existing priorities.**

Neil Henson explained how most of our offenders come from outside the Ward, and our best efforts to keep people safe is through target hardening, surveys and reinforcement of good practice. As our work on reducing burglaries is going to be a sustained piece of work it was agreed that this priority will run through until 31 March 2012. The other priorities will be ASB and preventing Cannabis factories.

### **Item 3 / 11 Community Engagement**

#### **Surgeries**

A new venue has been chosen for the surgeries, it is Linden Hall Day Centre, Hampton TW12 2JG. It will be every Wednesday, between 1pm and 2.30pm.

#### **Street briefings**

After reviewing previous street briefings and the profile of the population (a large number are commuters) it has been decided to run monthly briefings at Hampton Railway station. The dates are 17 March, 26 April, 26 May and 23 June 2011. The times for these will be between 4pm and 7pm. Morning events will also be undertaken on different days.

### **Item 4 / 11 Public Meeting**

We discussed the date and venue for the annual public meeting. It was decided to hold it in June (date yet to be confirmed) at the Hampton Football ground.

### **Item 5 / 11 Increase the membership of the PLG**

Dave Rees proposed a way of increasing the membership of the PLG. It involves selecting people representing different Watches etc. Further discussions will take place with ideas circulated via email.
