TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No 28) ORDER 2009

Made: 14 December 2009

Coming into operation: 4 January 2010

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 4 January 2010 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No 28) Order 2009.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though for the items numbered 14, 96, 100, 153, 181, 201, 238, 466, 578 and 652 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in lengths of Cambridge Road, Denton Road and Fairlawns at points where parked vehicles would obscure sight lines or where they would obstruct traffic turning into access ways.

The street referred to as "The Slipway" in the waiting and loading restriction consolidation order is referred to in this order as the "Richmond Road Slipway" as being a name which more readily identifies this street.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council has reviewed the operation of the East Twickenham controlled parking zone, particularly in relation to the provision of parking places for business permit holders, and has decided that there is scope to provide some additional parking places and to extend the length of some existing ones. Where bays have been under-utilised, the Council is proposing that they be redesignated as permit holder only bays, for the benefit of both residents and local businesses. Elsewhere, by extending parking bays into lengths of street where existing yellow lines are considered to be unnecessary, additional on-street parking may be provided. At certain junctions, the Council is proposing waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" on the grounds of road safety.

This order makes provision for the changes to the waiting restrictions.

A separate Order makes provision for the changes to the parking places.

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Parking Places Consolidation Order will be to:-
 - redesignate or extend (or both) a number of existing parking places within the streets listed above, all of which are within the East Twickenham controlled parking zone;
 - (b) introduce a number of new parking places in these streets; and
 - (c) consolidate into one order these changes and the previous amendments made to the East Twickenham parking places order of 1994.

Schedule 1 to this notice sets out the changes to the parking provision which is proposed for each of the streets.

- 3. The East Twickenham controlled parking zone operates on Mondays to Fridays between 10am and 4.30pm. Pay and display parking charges are on a graduated scale of 25p, 20p or 10p per 15 minute period, depending on the engine size or CO2 emission figure of the vehicle using the parking bay. The two lower charges may only be obtained if the driver has pre-registered the vehicle and has been issued with and uses a RichmondCard, or pays the charge by mobile telephone. Parking vouchers may be bought at various retail outlets at a cost of £0.50 per 30 minute voucher, £1.00 per 1 hour voucher and £2.00 per 2 hour voucher. Permit charges are also linked to the engine size or the CO2 emissions figures. Resident visitor permits are valid in bays where resident permits are valid. Full details of charges are available on request.
- 4. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to introduce a number of lengths of double yellow line restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in Cambridge Road, Denton Road and Fairlands, all as set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- 5. Copies of the proposed Orders, a plan showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected, quoting Reference 56/09, at:

- (a) Richmond Reference Library, Old Town Hall, Whittaker Avenue, Richmond TW9 1TP during opening hours, and
- (b) the Civic Centre (Planning Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.
- 6. An exhibition showing these proposals is currently on show on the ground floor of the Old Town Hall, and will remain open until 20 October.
- 7. THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (EAST TWICKENHAM) (PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION No. 2) ORDER 2009

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 28) ORDER 2009 (Reference 74/09)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on 14 December 2009 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Parking Places Consolidation Order is to:-
 - redesignate or extend (or both) a number of existing parking places within the streets listed above, all of which are within the East Twickenham controlled parking zone;
 - (b) introduce a number of new parking places in these streets; and
 - (c) consolidate into one order these changes and the previous amendments made to the East Twickenham parking places order of 1994.

Changes to the parking provision which are made by this order are the same as were proposed (notice of which was given on 9 October 2009), other than some minor variations in Clevedon Road, Cresswell Road, Denton Road, Fairlawns and Richmond Road. Schedule 1 to this notice gives particulars of the variations. For reference, the public notice of proposals may be viewed on the Council's website at www.richmond.gov.uk

- 3. The East Twickenham controlled parking zone operates on Mondays to Fridays between 10am and 4.30pm. Pay and display parking charges are on a graduated scale of 25p, 20p or 10p per 15 minute period, depending on the engine size or CO2 emission figure of the vehicle using the parking bay. The two lower charges may only be obtained if the driver has pre-registered the vehicle and has been issued with and uses a RichmondCard, or pays the charge by mobile telephone. Parking vouchers may be bought at various retail outlets at a cost of £0.50 per 30 minute voucher, £1.00 per 1 hour voucher and £2.00 per 2 hour voucher. Permit charges are also linked to the engine size or the CO2 emissions figures. Resident visitor permits are valid in bays where resident permits are valid. Full details of charges are available on request.
- 4. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order is to introduce a number of lengths of double yellow line restrictions ("no waiting at any time") in Cambridge Road, Denton Road and Fairlands. These changes are the same as were proposed (notice of which was given on 9 October 2009) other than some minor variations in Cambridge Road. Schedule 2 to this notice gives particulars of the

variations. For reference, the public notice of proposals may be viewed on the Council's website as above.

- 5. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 4 January 2010, plans showing the location and effect of the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 74/09, at:-
 - (a) Richmond Reference Library, Old Town Hall, Whittaker Avenue, Richmond TW9 1TP during opening hours, and
 - (b) the Civic Centre (Planning Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.
- 6. Copies of the Orders may be purchased from the Environment Directorate, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.
- 7. Persons wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

the extent of the waiting restrictions on the north-west side of the junction has been reduced (5 metres).
