ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ACT 2003 PART 4

Notice for the Dispersal of Groups and Removal of Persons Under the Age of 16 to their Home Address

The local Police and the Local Authority have both agreed that there are grounds to believe that members of the public have been intimidated, harassed, alarmed or distressed as a result of the presence or behaviour of two or more persons and that anti-social behaviour is a significant and persistent problem in the below affected area.

Relevant Locality (affected area)

Whitton Road (North) to j/w Kneller Road; Talma Gardens; Tayben Avenue; Chudleigh Road; Palmerston Road; Rugby Road; Whitton Road (South) Erncroft Way; Grimwood Road; Latham Road; March Road;Heathfield South; Heathfield North; Court Way; London Road to j/w King Street; Station Approach; Arragon Road (inc Garfield Road).

I, Clive Chalk, Chief Superintendent, Metropolitan Police with the consent of Gillian Norton being the relevant Local Authority, hereby authorise uniformed Constables and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs) to disperse groups as defined under Part 4 of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003 from the above area during the relevant period detailed below:

Relevant Period

To (time)	23:59	hrs (24 hour clock) ON (date)	1st October	(year)	2013

Directions

During the times and dates specified above a Constable / PCSO may give one or more of the following directions:

- λ **Tell people in the group to disperse** (either immediately or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- λ **Tell people who don't live in the affected area to leave** (either immediately or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- Tell people who don't live in the affected area not to return to the affected area or any part of it for such period (not exceeding 24 hours) from when the direction was given, as he / she may specify.

If you are under 16 you may not be allowed to be here between the hours of 9pm and 6am unless you are under the effective control of a parent or responsible person over the age of 18.

You may be removed to your home or place of safety if more appropriate.

TAKE NOTE:

To contravene a direction is an offence under Section 32 of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003, punishable by 3 months imprisonment and / or a fine not exceeding £2500.
