### **Teddington controlled parking zone study**

In December 2007 / January 2008 the Council consulted a number of roads around Teddington Station on a proposal to introduce a controlled parking zone (CPZ).

The results of the consultation, which showed that there was support in a number of roads around the station, were reported to the Transport Consultative Group on 30 January 2008. After this meeting the Cabinet Member approved the implementation of a CPZ in eleven roads around the station (see map overleaf).

The decision to implement the CPZ was subsequently referred to the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Committee on Tuesday 26 February 2008. The Committee accepted the Cabinet Member's decision to implement the CPZ. However, in the light of further representations (including petitions and surveys from local residents) and consideration of the consultation results the committee requested that residents of Avenue Road, Blackmores Grove, and Field Lane be re-consulted to see whether they would now wish to be included in the CPZ. The results of this consultation, which is now underway, will be analysed and reported to the Cabinet Member around the end of April 2008 / early May 2008. As per previous consultations, the results will be analysed on a road by road basis and a decision made as to whether to include one or more of these roads will be included in the CPZ.

**The new CPZ will come into operation on Monday 16 June 2008 and will operate between 8.30am and 10.30am, Monday to Friday.**

Further details of the decision to implement the CPZ and all yellow line proposals both inside and outside the CPZ boundary are available for inspection at Teddington library, Council Offices, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham and on the Council website:

The Council will review the CPZ after an approximate period of operation of three months.
