## **Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places**

(Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the above regulations, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames is required to conduct a review of polling districts and polling places.

The main purpose of this is to ensure that all electors in the borough have such reasonable and accessible facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances.

This is on a four-yearly cycle, and the next review is due by the end of 2011, covering all those polling districts and polling places used in connection with parliamentary elections held within the Twickenham and Richmond Park constituencies.

The review will commence on 1 July 2011 and must be completed in time to enable the Electoral Registration Officer to make any alterations necessary to the Register of Electors when it is next fully revised on 1 December 2011.

The Returning Officer will submit current electorate numbers and polling station venues for both parliamentary constituencies, and comments on the existing arrangements and any proposed alterations. Representations will be sought from any person or body with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with a disability.

Any registered elector within the Twickenham or Richmond Park constituencies may make representations on the location and suitability of their polling station and, where appropriate, include alternative venue suggestions that may be hired as polling places.
