Dear Owner / Occupier

South Twickenham Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) Review

In June 2009, the Council undertook a review of the operation of the South Twickenham CPZ (zone E) to establish whether the CPZ is working effectively or whether any amendments to the operational hours should be made.

Following the review consultation with residents and businesses located within the CPZ boundary, the Cabinet Member for Traffic, Transport and Parking approved the formal advertisement of proposals to:

- continue the operation of the current South Twickenham CPZ and maintain the current hours of control (Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 10.30am) in the majority of the zone
- change the hours of control for the section of Waldegrave Gardens between Tower Road and Waldegrave Road to operate for 4 hours, Monday to Friday, from 10.30am – 2.30pm.

Please note, while this section of Waldegrave Gardens will require new zone entry and exit signs, these changes will not involve any changes to permits and all E zone permits will continue to be valid in the E zone. In addition you should be aware that although the resident visitor permit scratch card has a box for “8am – 2pm”, these permits will in fact be valid between 8.30am and 2.30pm for cars parked in the E zone.

The Council are also proposing to create extra parking areas by removing sections of yellow line and re-designate a number of parking bays to maximise the overall parking capacity in the area. The proposals have been developed to address the local parking concerns raised as a result of the review.

Furthermore it is proposed to extend permit eligibility to properties 29 & 48 Tower Road for parking permits within the zone E CPZ.

These proposals are being formally advertised by way of traffic management orders on **Friday 27 November 2009**. Plans detailing this information will also be available from this date at the Twickenham Library, Garfield Road, Twickenham, at the Council offices, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham during opening hours and on the Council's website at http://www.richmond.gov.uk/south_twickenham_cpz_review.htm.

Representations are invited by letter to the Head of Highways and Transport, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham, TW1 3BZ or by email to highwaysandtransport@richmond.gov.uk. The Council is giving five weeks for representations to be received on or by **Monday 4 January 2010** due to the holiday period.

All representations received will be reported to the Cabinet Member, following which further information will be posted advising of scheduled implementation of the proposals and of any other minor operational changes in the area which are deemed necessary.
