

## **Proposed enlargement and increase in the admission number of Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, on behalf of the Governors of Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School and the Diocese of Southwark Board of Education, intends to make a prescribed alteration to Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School (voluntary-aided), Carrington Road, off Manor Road, Richmond, TW10 5AA, from 1 September 2010.


It is proposed that with effect from the 2010/2011 school year intake, the admission number of the school should be permanently increased to 60. The admission number will increase to 60 for Year 1 in 2012/2013, for Year 2 to 60 in 2013/2014, and so on until 2017/2018 when the admission number for all year-groups will be 60.

The current capacity of the school is 210 and the proposed capacity will be 420. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 173. The current admission number for the school is 30 and the proposed admission number will be 60.
