

Proposed enlargement and increase in the admission number of St Mary's and St Peter's Church of England Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, on behalf of the Governors of St Mary's and St Peter's Church of England Primary School and the Diocese of London Board for Schools, intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Mary's and St Peter's Church of England Primary School (voluntary-aided), Somerset Road, Teddington, TW11 8RX, from 1 September 2011.


It is proposed that with effect from the 2011/2012 school year intake, the admission number of the school should be permanently increased to 90.

The current capacity of the school is 420 and the proposed capacity will be 630. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 451. The current admission number for the school is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 90.
