

Proposals to close Stanley Infant and Nursery School; and to expand the age-range and increase the admission number of Stanley Junior School (and re-name it as 'Stanley Primary School')


Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that London Borough of Richmond upon Thames intends to discontinue Stanley Infant and Nursery School (community), Strathmore Road, Teddington, TW11 8UE, on 31 August 2010; and to make prescribed alterations to Stanley Junior School (community), Stanley Road, Teddington, TW11 8UE, from 1 September 2010.

Children attending Stanley Infant and Nursery School, including those in the Moderate Language Difficulties Unit, on 31 August 2010 will be accommodated in Stanley Junior School (which would be renamed Stanley Primary School and which is adjacent to Stanley Infant and Nursery School).

It is also proposed to: expand the age-range of Stanley Junior School so that it admits children aged 4-11; and to increase the admission number from 90 to 120. There are currently 321 pupils in Stanley Infant and Nursery School and 354 in Stanley Junior School. The current capacity per year-group of Stanley Junior is 90 and the proposed capacity of 'Stanley Primary' will be 120. The current admission number for the school is 90 and the proposed admission number of 'Stanley Primary' will be 120.
