

## **Proposed enlargement, and increase in the admission number, of Chase Bridge Primary School**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, on behalf of the Governors of Chase Bridge Primary School, intends to make a prescribed alteration to Chase Bridge Primary School, Kneller Road, Twickenham, TW2 7DE, from 1 September 2011.

It is proposed that with effect from the 2011/2012 school year intake, the admission number of the school should be permanently increased to 90.


The current capacity of the school is 420 and the proposed capacity will be 630 (plus 52 part-time nursery places). The current number of pupils registered at the school is 449. The current admission number for the school is 60 and the proposed admission number will be 90.

It is also proposed that the pre-school that currently provides 24 places on the school's site should become part of the school as a community nursery school, with 26 morning and 26 afternoon places.
