

Sheen Lane Centre Scheme

The surface materials proposed for this scheme

Breedon Gravel will be used around the trees in this scheme.

Yorkstone is to be laid at the entrance to Sheen Lane centre. This will provide a smart entry point.

Heritage Sealed Gravel is to be used throughout the Sheen Lane centre, set off at the edges of the buildings with Yorkstone.

The surfaces we are proposing are in Richmond in the following locations:

York Stone in Lower George Street (the pedestrianised area with Robert Dyas on it)

Heritage Sealed Gravel – on the towpath between Richmond and Twickenham Bridge and footways in Ham and Petersham.

Breedon Gravel – on the footpath across Richmond Green.

Heritage gravel is a sandy golden colour. The gravel is set within a bonded material so that it does not move about. It has been chosen by the design team for landscape works to this area (as opposed to Yorkstone throughout) for the following reasons:

- Its soft appearance
 - Lightens up the look of a fairly dark space
 - Is a foil to the harsh looking buildings
 - Makes the area look less urban
- It is sympathetic to areas of plants and trees
- It has good permeable drainage
- It has a good grip
- Cost – this is a large space of approx 25x 50 metres.

An example of Heritage Sealed Gravel is in the library behind the counter.
