## **SCHEDULE 5**

### **Use of the Richmond Card**

- 1 Any person (whether or not resident or working in Richmond upon Thames) may apply for a Richmond Card, and must supply such details as the Council may require for the vehicle to be registered and the correct tier of parking charge to be encoded on the card. Owners of vehicles which fall into Tier 3 (and do not qualify for a discounted parking charge) are eligible to apply for a Richmond Card which may be used as a means of paying for a parking charge.
- 2 The Council will provide a number of ways for card-holders to acquire a credit balance on the card (although such methods are not prescribed by the orders).
- 3 On using a pay and display machine (either on-street or at a "pay and display" off-street car park), if the driver inserts the Richmond Card in the ticket machine the machine will select the appropriate tariff and the driver may pay the parking charge by cash, by credit or debit card or by using the Richmond Card (the machine will deduct the correct amount from the credit balance). The parking ticket will include the registration number of the vehicle encoded on the card, and it will be a contravention to display a ticket with any registration number other than that of the vehicle parked in the parking place printed thereon. Without the card, the Tier 3 tariff will apply, no registration number will be involved, and no subsequent claim may be made against the Council for a discounted charge.
- 4 The use of a Richmond Card at pay on foot off-street car parks (specified in Schedule 2B) will be dependent on the equipment used at these locations.
- 5 If the Council have reason to believe that a Richmond Card has been deliberately or fraudulently misused it may disable or withdraw that card. Lost cards may be replaced on payment of an administration charge of £10, and any credit which remained on the card at the time when it was reported lost will be added to the replacement card.

## **SCHEDULE 6**

### **Timetable to implement the proposals**

- STEP 1 APPLICATION FOR A RICHMOND CARD ISSUED FREE OF CHARGE**  
On the day the orders come into force (public notice of which will be given by the Council – see Note 1 and Note 3) applications may be made for a Richmond Card, and the Council will, subject to a satisfactory application, issue it free of charge. The Council will, until the Step 3 date, issue only one card to any one person free of charge, and the administration charge for a replacement card will be levied in all cases.
- STEP 2 NEW TARIFFS AT TEDDINGTON CAR PARKS and INTRODUCTION OF DIFFERENTIAL PARKING CHARGES, STAGE 1**  
4 weeks after the Step 1 date, the following measures will come into force:-
- (a) the proposed charges at Cedar Road car park, North Lane (east side), North Lane (west side) and Teddington pool and gym car park, Vicarage Road, Teddington specified in Schedule 1A; and
  - (b) car park controls at the Teddington Memorial Hospital,
  - (c) the differential parking charges as tabulated in Schedule 4 in respect of:-
    - (i) the pay and display off-street cars parks specified in Schedules 1A, 1B and 2A; and
    - (ii) all on-street pay and display parking bays specified in Schedule 3.
- STEP 3 CHARGES FOR A RICHMOND CARD**  
4 weeks after the Step 2 date the Council will levy the charge for the issue of a Richmond Card (being £2.50, see in paragraph 5 of the Notice). Any person whose application for a Richmond Card is received by the Council on or after this Step 3 date will be required to pay the charge before the card is issued. The deadline for receipt of an application for a free Richmond Card (as Step 1) will be 5pm on the last working day (which excludes Saturdays, Sundays and bank and public holidays) before the Step 3 date.
- STEP 4 INTRODUCTION OF DIFFERENTIAL PARKING CHARGES, STAGE 2**  
On or after the Step 2 date the differential parking charges tabulated in Schedule 4 will come into force at the pay on foot off-street car parks specified in Schedule 2B. The Council will give at least 21 days public notice of the date when this step will come into force – see Note 1 and Note 3.

### **NOTES TO SCHEDULE 6**

- 1 Public notices (referred to in Step 1 and Step 4) will be published at least once in a newspaper circulating in the borough.
- 2 The Council will arrange for such other publicity as it sees fit.
- 3 Without prejudice to any representations which may be received, or to any due consideration which the Council will give to such representations, the Council has in mind that Steps 1-3 will be introduced on 3 August, 1 September and 5 October 2009 respectively. No date has been proposed for Step 4 which, in any case, is also dependent on any representations and consideration thereof.

## SCHEDULE 7

### Special parking charges

- 1 The proposed orders make provision that special, or concessionary, parking charges may be introduced, varied and terminated by giving at least 21 days notice of such introduction, variation or termination (in a manner similar to that described in note 1 to Schedule 6 above).
- 2 The Council is intending to introduce the special charges specified below to assist local businesses on dates to be in accordance with the timetable given in Schedule 6. The commencement notice mentioned in item 1 of this Schedule insofar as it refers to on-street pay and display bays, to pay and display off-street car parks and to a £1.00 maximum charge for current parking charges at pay on foot car parks will be the notice mentioned in Step 1 in Schedule 6, and insofar as it refers to the £1.50 or £1.00 maximum charge for differential parking charges at pay on foot off-street car parks will be the notice mentioned in Step 4.

### ON-STREET PAY AND DISPLAY BAYS

The special parking charge set out in the following table is proposed at all on-street pay and display bays (except Upper Teddington Road, Hampton Wick where parking periods are paid for in hourly intervals). This concession will apply only at the time of arrival.

This tariff applies only to parking periods of 20 minutes or less.

### OFF-STREET CAR PARKS

A maximum parking charge is proposed at most off-street car parks for vehicles which enter any car park at or after 3.00pm and before 6.30pm on any Thursday. Any maximum stay which is otherwise in force for periods of 1, 2 or 3 hours will be waived for the remainder of that day, other than at Teddington Memorial Hospital where it will be waived until 6.30pm. Drivers may park for shorter periods, in accordance with the tariffs proposed elsewhere in this notice, and the charge for such periods will in all cases be less than or equal to the maximum charge as specified here.

This tariff is not available to drivers who enter any off-street car park before 3pm on a Thursday.

At Paradise Road car park, Richmond, the special parking charge will apply between 3pm and 6.30pm on Thursdays, after which the flat rate evening tariff will apply until midnight.

At Arragon Road car park, Twickenham, the special parking charge will apply between 3pm and 6.30pm on Thursdays, after which parking is free until midnight.

At Teddington Memorial Hospital car park the special parking charge will apply between 3pm and 6.30pm on Thursdays, after which the normal tariff will apply until 10pm.

The special tariffs shown in the table above will apply at pay and display car parks as from the Step 2 date (see Schedule 6) and at pay on foot car parks as from the Step 4 date. At pay on foot car parks, a special tariff of £1.00 maximum charge will apply to current charges as from the Step 2 date.

### **SCHEDULE 8**

#### **Other matters not affected by the proposed orders**

- 1 In controlled parking zones where parking vouchers are in use, vouchers may continue to be used as payment of the parking charge.  
The zones where parking vouchers apply are East Sheen, East Twickenham, Hampton Court, The Alberts, Townshend, North-East Richmond and St Margaret's South.
- 2 Charges for residents' parking permits, residents' visitor's permits and business parking permits are not affected by the proposals given in this notice.
