Dear Resident / Businesses

Consultation – Twickenham Event R Zone / Weekday controlled parking zone (CPZ)

I should like to thank you for responding to the recent consultation on parking in your area. This concerned the possible extension to the area of the RFU Twickenham event “R” Zone and/or a possible weekday controlled parking zone.

I am now able to let you know formally the results of the consultation and the decision of the Cabinet Member for Traffic, Transport and Parking.

Out of over 2000 questionnaires issued 886 (42%) were returned. Overall 477 (54%) of residents and businesses who responded were not in favour of either possible parking controls. There was no group of roads that together would form an extension to the “R zone” and there were only two roads in favour of weekday controls.

I reported these results to the Transport Consultative Group (TCG) on 17th June. This Group consists of councillors from both political parties and lay members with experience in traffic issues. Its role is to advise the Cabinet Member prior to him making his decision.

You will wish to know that the Cabinet member has decided to:-

- (i) progress no further with an extension to the Twickenham Event “R” Zone, and,
- (ii) progress no further with a new weekday controlled parking zone.
