



**ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ACT 2003
PART 4**

**Notice for the Dispersal of Groups
and Removal of Persons Under the
Age of 16 to their Home Address**

The local Police and the Local Authority have both agreed that there are grounds to believe that members of the public have been intimidated, harassed, alarmed or distressed as a result of the presence or behaviour of two or more persons and that anti-social behaviour is a significant and persistent problem in the below affected area.

Relevant Locality (affected area)

St Margarets - Cambridge Road, Arosa Road, Clevedon Road, Riverside between Denton Road and Richmond Bridge, Richmond Road from Richmond Bridge to Cambridge Park.

Richmond - Richmond Bridge, Bridge Street, Hill Rise, Compass Hill, Howson Terrace, Petersham Road, Richmond Riverside to Buccleugh Gdns, Nightingale lane Richmond Hill, The Vineyard (to the Junction with Mt. Arrarat Road, Mt

Arrarat Road, Paradise Road, Grosvenor Road, Grove Road, Halford Road, Ormond Road, The Hermitage, Red Lion Street, Lewis Road, Castle Yard, Wakefield Road, Church Terrace, Sheen Road to the Junction with Lichfield Terrace, Drummond Place, Kew Road to Richmond Circus, Twickenham Road to Twickenham Bridge, Riverside to Petersham Road, Parkshot, Clarence Street, Little Green, Park Lane, The area and roads surrounding Richmond Green, Old Palace Lane, Old Palace Yard, Cholmondly Walk, Friars Lane, King Street, Water Lane, Hill Street, Duke Street, Quadrant Road, The Quadrant, Brewers Lane, Golden Court, Victoria Place, Waterloo Place, Eton Street.

North Richmond - Kew Foot Road, Rosedale Road, Shaftesbury Road, Evelyn Road, Evelyn Terrace, Jocelyn Road, Old Deer Gardens, Kew Road to Old Deer Gardens, Selwyn Ave, Lower Mortlake Road to Sheendale Road, Pools on the Park, Old Deer Recreation Ground to the Thames. Map Attached

I, Clive Chalk, Chief Superintendent, Metropolitan Police with the consent of Gillian Norton being the relevant Local Authority, hereby authorise uniformed Constables and Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs) to disperse groups as defined under Part 4 of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003 from the above area during the relevant period detailed below:

Relevant Period

From (time)	00:01	hrs (24 hour clock) ON (date)	24 May	(year)	2013
To (time)	23:59	hrs (24 hour clock) ON (date)	23 November	(year)	2013

Directions

During the times and dates specified above a Constable / PCSO may give one or more of the following directions:

- λ **Tell people in the group to disperse** (either immediately or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- λ **Tell people who don't live in the affected area to leave** (either immediately or at a stated time and in a stated way).
- λ **Tell people who don't live in the affected area not to return to the affected area** or any part of it for such period (not exceeding 24 hours) from when the direction was given, as he / she may specify.

If you are under 16 you may not be allowed to be here between the hours of 9pm and 6am unless you are under the effective control of a parent or responsible person over the age of 18.

You may be removed to your home or place of safety if more appropriate.

TAKE NOTE:

To contravene a direction is an offence under Section 32 of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003, punishable by 3 months imprisonment and / or a fine not exceeding £2500.
