TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT No. 9) ORDER 2008

Made: 29 September 2008

Coming into operation: 13 October 2008

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 13 October 2008 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2008.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Consolidation No. 8) Order 2008(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the items numbered 182, 307, 317, 338, 480, 651 and 776 in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered 388A and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

Note 1

HAM COMMON

The south-western arm serves Nos 1-25 Ham Common and runs from its junction with Upper Ham Road (near the Cassel Hospital) to its junction with Lock Road.

The north-western arm serves Nos 27-49 Ham Common and runs from that junction with Ham Street which lies to the north of the church of St Thomas Aquinas to its junction with the northern arm near No 49 Ham Common.

The northern arm serves No 50 Ham Common, "Avenue Lodge" and St Michaels Convent, and runs from that junction with Ham Street which lies to the south of the church of St Thomas Aquinas (opposite Lock Road) to its junction with Upper Ham Road (opposite Ham Gate Avenue).

The north-eastern arm serves "Hardwicke House" No 58 Ham Common, "South Lodge" Nos 59-66 Ham Common and Nos 68-69 Ham Common, and runs from its junction with the northern arm (at its junction with Martingales Close) to its junction with Upper Ham Road and Petersham Road.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order:-

- (a) introduces waiting restrictions ("no waiting at any time"):-
 - (i) at the junction of Hanworth Road with Nightingale Road, Hampton;
 - (ii) in a length of Ham Common, Ham and at the junction of Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham;
- (b) alters the waiting restrictions from "no waiting between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" to "no waiting between 8am and 6.30pm throughout the week" (that is, seven days a week) in a length of Wellington Road, Teddington near its junction with Sixth Cross Road and South Road (and affects a length of 20 metres in Sixth Cross Road at that junction); and
- (c) alters the waiting restrictions from "no waiting between 8am and 9.30am on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" to "no waiting at any time" in a length of High Street, Hampton Hill at its junction with the exit from the High Street car park (Cricket Lane), and makes a small adjustment to the length of the restriction in Cricket Lane to suit existing conditions.

STATEMENT OF REASONS The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 9) Order 2008

The restrictions are being introduced to prevent obstructive or dangerous parking at various locations in the borough, and so prevent delays to traffic, in particular to buses, thereby enabling operators to provide a more reliable bus service.

- 2. The general effect of this Order is to:-
 - (a) introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time":-
 - (i) at the junction of Hanworth Road with Nightingale Road, Hampton;
 - (ii) in a length of Ham Common, Ham and at the junction of Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham;
 - (b) alter the waiting restrictions from "no waiting between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" to "no waiting between 8am and 6.30pm throughout the week" (that is, seven days a week) in a length of Wellington Road, Teddington near its junction with Sixth Cross Road and South Road (including a length of 20 metres in Sixth Cross Road at that junction); and
 - (c) alter the waiting restrictions from "no waiting between 8am and 9.30am on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive" to "no waiting at any time" in a length of High Street, Hampton Hill at its junction with the exit from the High Street car park (Cricket Lane).
- 3. On 23 May 2008 the Council gave notice of its proposals to introduce the above and similar waiting restrictions at three other locations throughout the borough. Of the three other locations, the Council has:-
 - (a) previously made an order in respect of Martingales Close, Ham at its junction with Ham Common; and
 - (b) deferred making a decision in respect of the proposals:-
 - (i) in lengths of Church Street, Hampton; and
 - (ii) at the junction of High Street with Park Close, Hampton.
