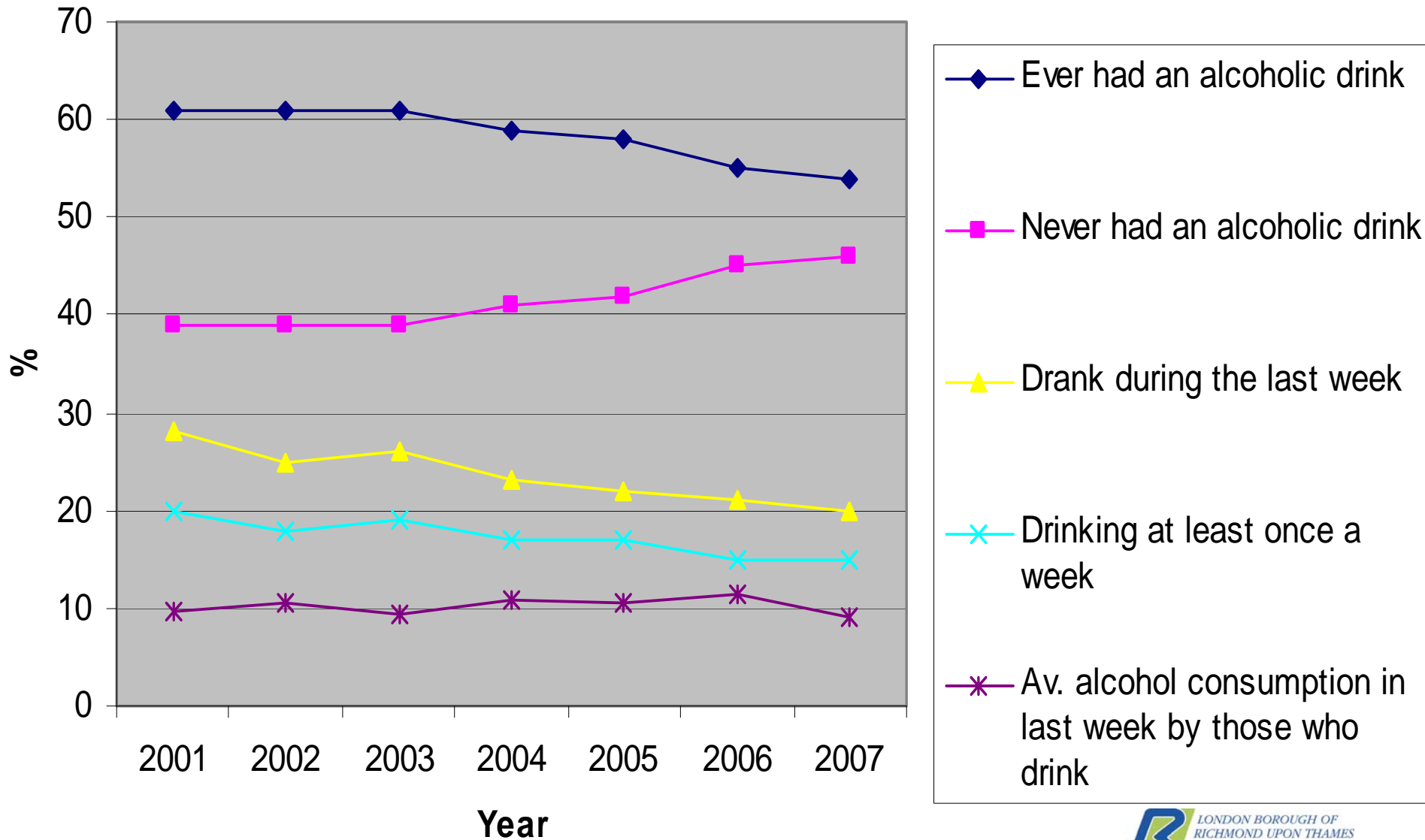

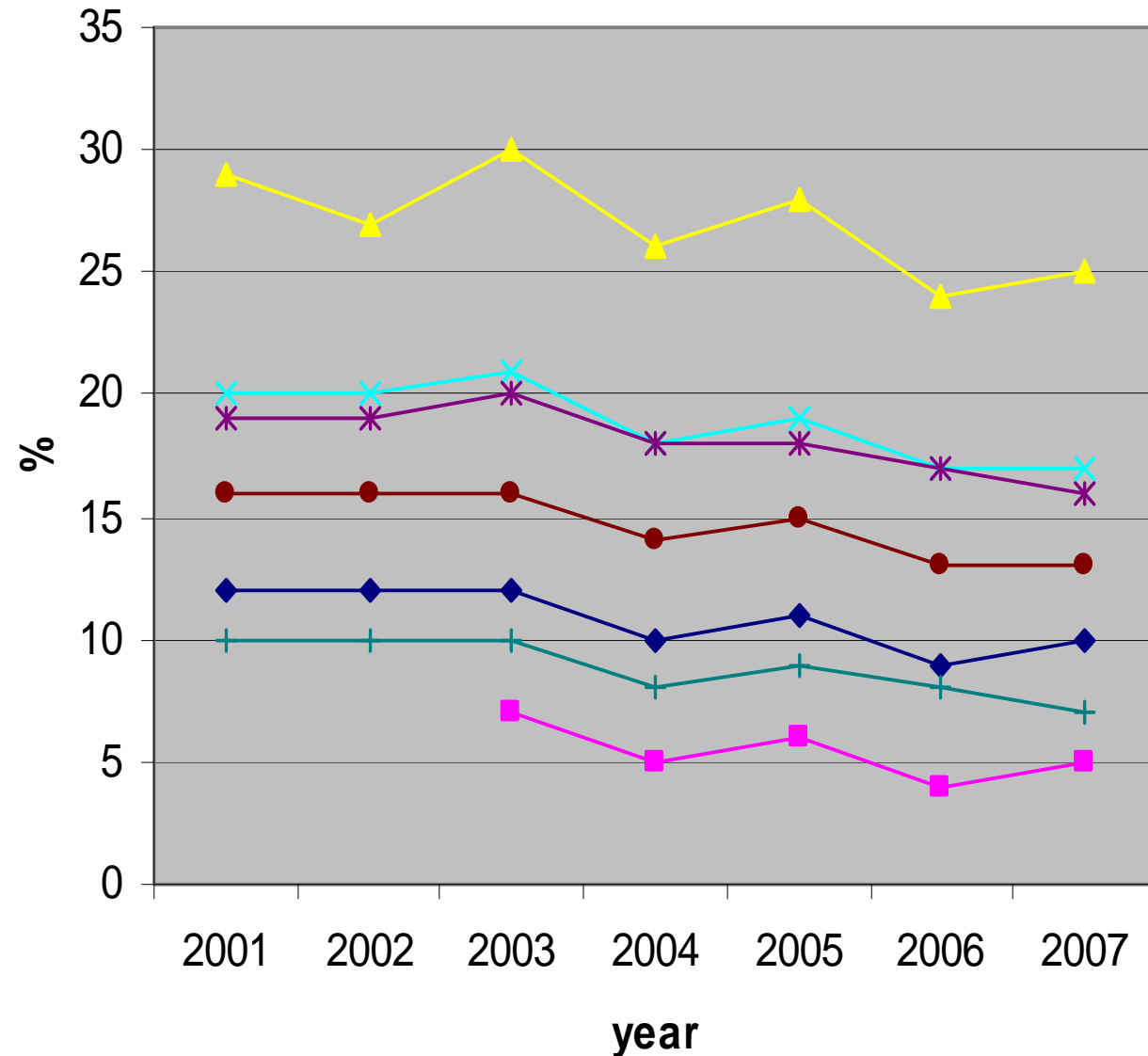

National Alcohol Trends (11-15)

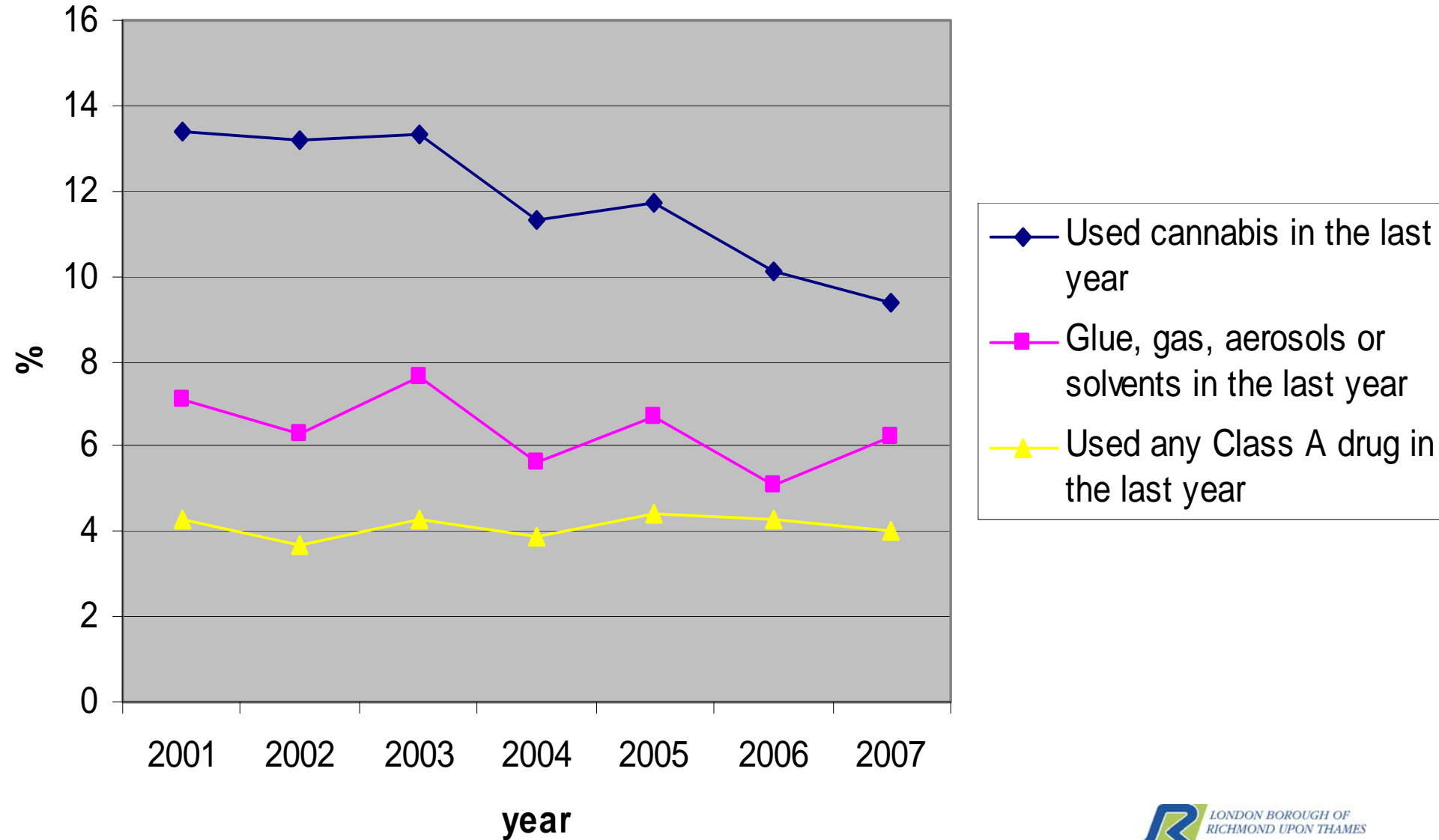


National Drug trends (11-15)

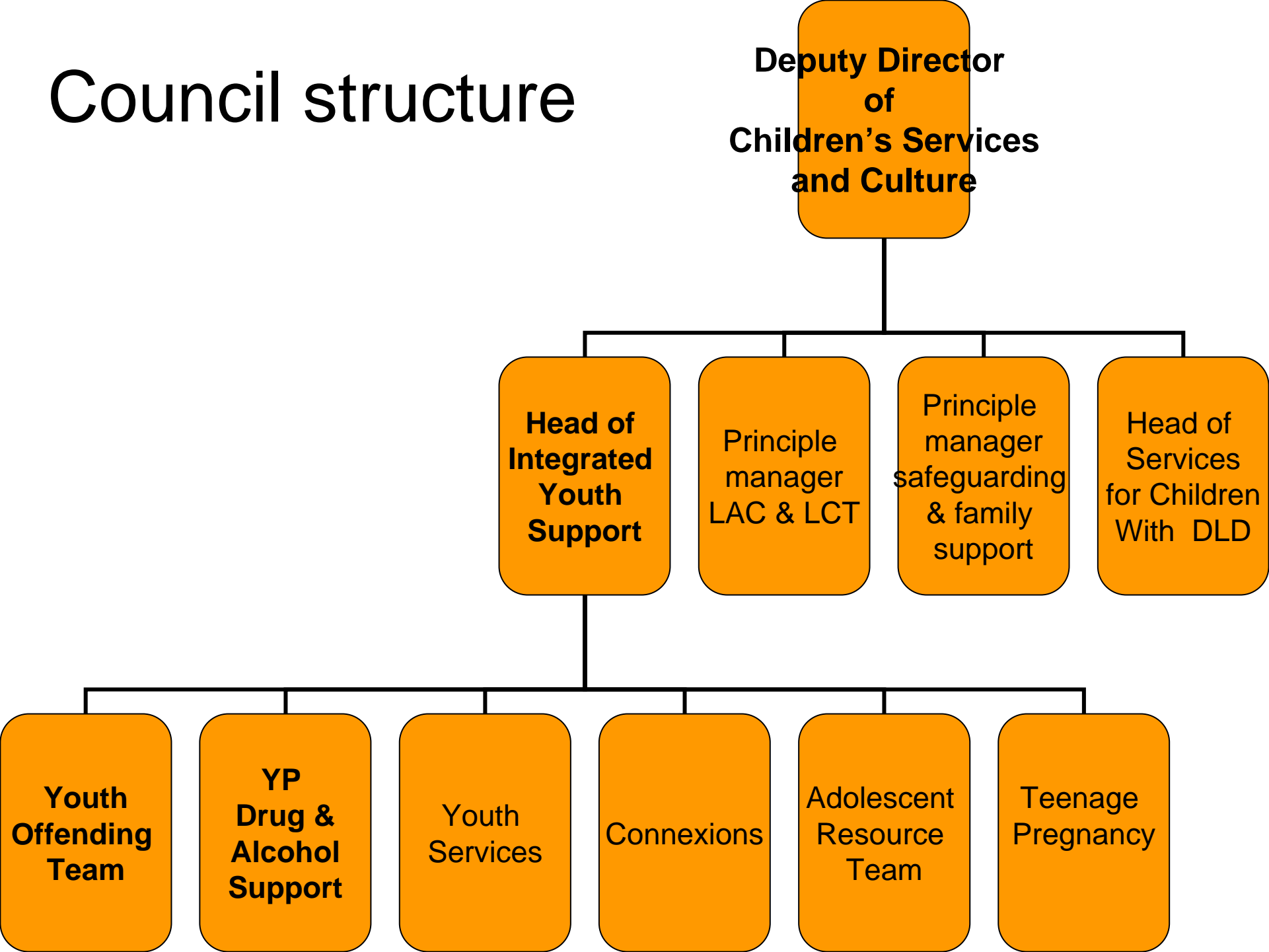

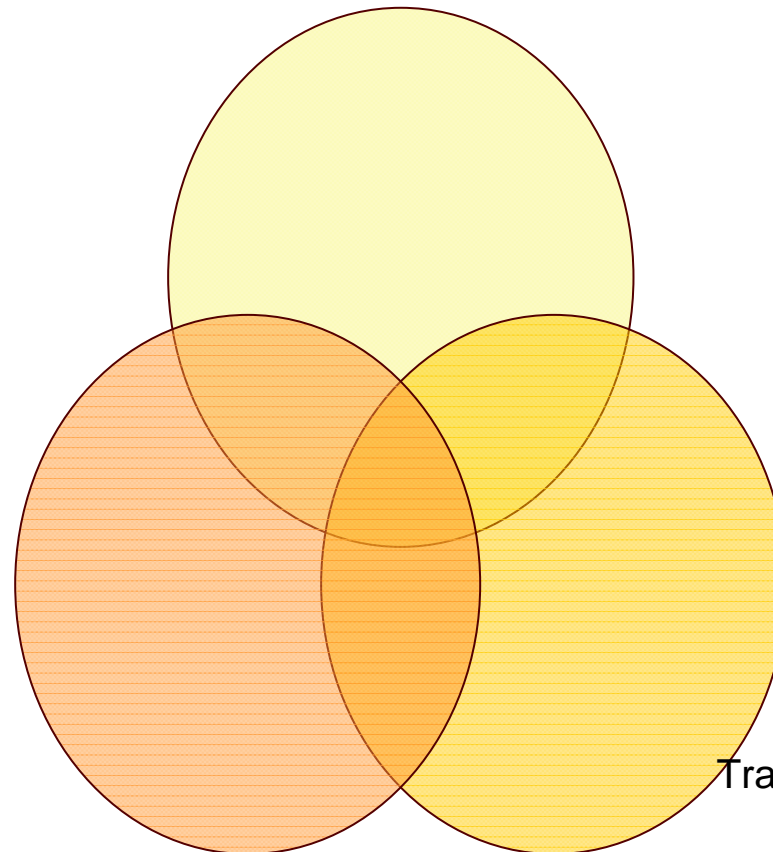

Tier 4: Access to detox and rehab

Tier 3: Comprehensive assessment and psychosocial interventions including counselling and psychotherapy – one-to-one or groups may be long-term, usually multi-agency

Tier 2: Targeted education for harm reduction in and out of school using informal outreach and structured sessions often brief interventions

Tier 1 – Universal education in schools

- Provided by voluntary sector partners
- Meet upwards of 3,000 young people per year
- Work in schools, colleges, youth clubs, Travellers site, events, etc

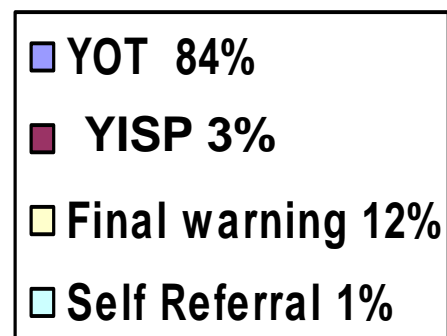
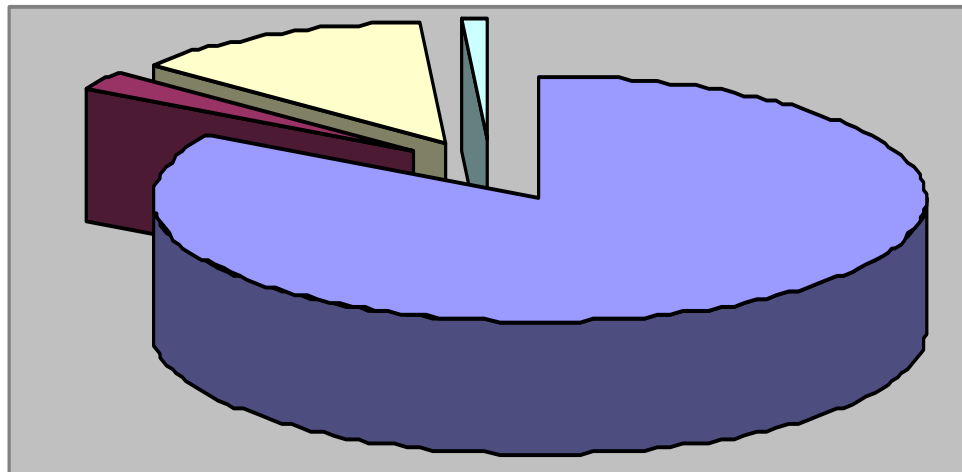
YOT Services

Pre Court (voluntary):

- YISP
- Reprimands
- Final warnings

Post Court (statutory):

- Community Court Orders
- Custodial sentences

Offences

- 321 offences committed in 08/09, of which 14.3% were drugs offences
- 5th highest assessed factor to affect likelihood of re-offending

Referrals

YP referred to YOT Substance Misuse worker if:

- ASSET drugs and alcohol score is 2 or more
- Specified component of a court order

Referrals to YPDAS:

- Directly by any professional, family member or self

No Myths

Performance

- 100% referrals assessed and treatment started if needed within 10 working days
- YOT referrals = 80; YPDAS = 103
- 25% require tier 3/4 treatment
- Remainder tier 2, Hidden Harm or inappropriate
