

Local Development Framework Core Strategy Adoption Statement: April 2009

The Core Strategy was adopted on 21 April 2009. The Core Strategy is a Development Plan Document which is part of the Local Development Framework. It is the strategic policy document which will determine the future planning policy for the Borough and outlines the Vision, Spatial Strategy and Core Planning Policies.

The Core Strategy* was considered by an independent Inspector at Examination in November and December 2008. The Inspector's Report was published on 26 February 2009 and can be viewed at the locations set out below and on the Council's web site at www.richmond.gov.uk/ldf. The adopted Core Strategy incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. Any challenge must be made on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made no later than 6 weeks after the date of this notice, i.e. **5 June 2009**.
