

Section Markers

Section markers can be purchased by anyone who may wish to have a permanent piece of infrastructure dedicated from themselves, their business, a friend or relative. They have also been donated in the past by people who have enjoyed working in, or visiting, the cemetery.

The marker has the inscription "donated by" rather than "in loving memory of" as it is not intended to be a personal memorial.

It is hoped, in time, that all sections of the cemeteries will be marked in this way, to make it easier for people to locate graves.

You can ask the cemetery staff which sections need a marker. If there is a certain area you would like, for example a plot with your initial, please let us know and we will try to meet your request.

The price of a Section Marker will be confirmed by the cemetery office at the time of your enquiry. The cost includes your inscription, delivery and installation. Payment can be made by debit card, cheque (payable to L.B.R.U.T), in cash or by credit card, which is subject to a handling fee
