PARKING PLACES ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (CENTRAL TWICKENHAM) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 8) ORDER 2009

Made: 15 June 2009

Coming into operation: 22 June 2009

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46 and 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- This Order shall come into operation on 22 June 2009 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Central Twickenham) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 8) Order 2009.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Central Twickenham) (Parking Places) Order 2003(c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) the item numbered 2A/1 in Schedule 2A to that Order was revoked; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 7A to that Order the item numbered 7A/1A and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order.

ITEM TO BE ADDED TO SCHEDULE 7A [to 2003/58]

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 8.30 AM AND 6.30 PM ON MONDAYS TO SATURDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE MAXIMUM PARKING PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IS FOUR HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID TICKET FROM A TICKET PARKING METER OR IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS', RESIDENTS' VISITORS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order alters the designation of a parking place (two parking bays) in Cheltenham Avenue from a pay and display (maximum stay 2 hours) parking place to a shared use parking place, where a pay and display ticket is valid for a maximum stay of 4 hours or where a resident's permit or residents' visitors' permit is valid throughout the controlled hours, these being 8.30am to 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following representations received from residents, a parking place is to be altered so as to allow shared use parking (Pay and Display or residents permit parking) to provide more versatile parking and meet local demand. The parking bay is within the Central Twickenham controlled parking zone, the hours of operation of which are between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
