PARKING PLACES ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (THE ALBERTS) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 3) ORDER 2003

Made: 19 May 2003

Coming into operation: 26 May 2003

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of its powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of, and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 **(a)** as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 **(b)**, the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986 **(c)**, the Parking Act 1989 **(d)** and the Road Traffic Act 1991 **(e)** and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-


1. This Order shall come into operation on 26 May 2003 and may be cited as The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (The Alberts) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2003.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into effect of this Order, The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (The Alberts) (Parking Places) Order 1994 **(f)**, as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) at the beginning of Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to that Order there were substituted for the first sentence the following – “In relation to a parking place referred to in this Schedule the expression “permitted hours” means the period between 10 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday”;
 - (b) for the item in Schedule 1 to that Order numbered 1/1 there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order;

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 10AM AND 4.30PM ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY

PARKING PLACES IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE MAXIMUM PARKING PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IS FOUR HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID PARKING VOUCHER OR VOUCHERS, OR IN WHICH IT MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS' RESIDENTS' VISITORS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS', RESIDENTS' VISITORS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order:-

- (a) amends the operational hours of The Alberts controlled parking zone from "8.30am - 6.30pm Mondays to Fridays" to "10am - 4.30pm Mondays to Fridays";
- (b) increases the length of a shared-use resident/voucher parking place in Albert Road, Richmond adjacent to No 4 Worple Way in place of an existing double yellow line;
- (c) increases the length of a resident permit holder parking place in Audley Road, Richmond outside Nos 4 to 8 Audley Road in place of an existing single yellow line;
- (d) increases the length of a resident permit holder parking place in Beatrice Road, Richmond outside Nos 4 to 6 Beatrice Road in place of an existing single yellow line;
- (e) redefines and reduces the length of a residents permit holder parking place in York Road, Richmond on the whole of its south side in place of an existing single yellow line.
