## PARKING PLACES ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (HAMPTON COURT) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 1995



Made 27th February 1995

Coming into operation 6th March 1995

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Parts III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 6th March 1995and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Hampton Court)(Parking Places)(Amendment No. 1) Order 1995.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Hampton Court)(Parking Places) Order 1994 (c) shall have effect as though:
  - (a) for the item numbered 2/1 of Schedule 2 to that Order there was substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order;
  - (b) for the items numbered 3/1 and 3/2 of Schedule 3 to that Order there were substituted the items similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 2 to this Order.



## SCHEDULE 1

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 8.30 AM AND 6.30 PM THROUGHOUT THE WEEK, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE MAXIMUM PARKING PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IS FOUR HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID PARKING VOUCHER OR VOUCHERS OR IF A PARKING CHARGE IS PAID TO A TICKET PARKING METER OF IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS', RESIDENTS' VISITORS, BUSINESS OR OPERATIONAL PERMIT.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Hampton Court)(Parking Places) Order 1994, so as to introduce an additional length of residents parking space on the north side of Hampton Court Road and to relocate residents parking spaces and four hour voucher parking spaces on the south side.
