
PARKING PLACES ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (KEW) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 8) ORDER 2008

Made: 21 July 2008

Coming into operation: 28 July 2008

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**(a)**, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985**(b)**, the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991**(c)**, the Traffic Management Act 2004**(d)** and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 28 July 2008 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Kew) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 8) Order 2008.
2.
 - (1) In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978**(e)** shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:-
 - (a) the items numbered 1/21 and 1/22 in Schedule 1 to the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Kew) (Parking Places) Order 2004**(f)**, as amended, are hereby revoked;
 - (b) that Order shall have effect as though:-
 - (i) there were substituted for the item numbered 3/72 in Schedule 3 to that Order the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (ii) there were added to the items in Schedule 3 to that Order the item numbered 3/72A as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (iii) there were made the amendments to that Order as set out in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order as a consequence of the coming into force of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

Article 12	Substitute the whole of this Article as follows – “If a vehicle is left in a parking place referred to in Schedule 1, Schedule 2, Schedule 3 or Schedule 4 during the permitted hours without complying with the requirements of this Order a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer or served by the Council.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order alters three parking bays (with space for 5 cars in total) in Princes Road within the Kew controlled parking zone (hours of operation being 10am to 12 noon on Mondays to Fridays inclusive) from spaces in which parking is currently free but limited to a maximum stay of 1 hour into parking spaces where vehicles which display a valid residents', residents visitors, business or multi-zone business permit holders may park.

This Order also makes some minor changes to the text of the parent order as a consequence of the coming into force of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

The alterations to the parking provision in Princes Road, Kew are being made as a part of a review of the waiting restrictions and parking provision in the vicinity of the Broomfield House School, and is intended to be of benefit to local residents and business users.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
2. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Order** will be to introduce waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time" as follows (and specified in Schedule 1):-
 - (a) in parts of these streets:-
 - (i) Langham House Close, Ham;
 - (ii) Melliss Avenue, Kew,
 - (iii) Mill Hill Road, Barnes;
 - (iv) Mowbray Road, Ham;

- (v) Townmead Road, Kew,
 - (vi) Victoria Cottages, Kew; and
- (b) at these road junctions:-
- (i) Ashburnham Road with Mowbray Road, Ham;
 - (ii) Cedars Road with Mill Hill Road;
 - (iii) Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham,
 - (iv) Lower Richmond Road with Rosemary Lane and Langdon Place, Mortlake,
 - (v) Petersham Road, Richmond with Tree Close, Petersham; and
 - (vi) Rocks Lane with Mill Hill Road, Barnes.
3. The general effect of the **Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order** will be to alter school keep clear zig-zag markings in Broomfield Road, Kew and Sheen Lane, Richmond, as specified in Schedule 2.
4. The general effect of the **Short Stay Parking Places Order** will be to introduce in Kew Green, Kew a parking place to operate every day of the year between 10am and 4.30pm in which vehicles may park for a maximum stay of 1 hour, as specified in Schedule 3.
5. The general effect of the **Richmond Town Parking Places Order** will be to alter ten parking meter bays in Sheen Park, Richmond into parking places for residents' parking permit holders only, as specified in Schedule 4.
6. The general effect of the **Richmond Hill Parking Places Order** will be to alter two parking bays for permit holders only in Nightingale Lane, Richmond to a parking place for the shared use of permit holders and pay and display parking with a maximum stay of 4 hours, and to extend the length of the parking place, as specified in Schedule 5.
7. The general effect of the **Kew Parking Places Order** will be as follows (and specified in Schedule 6):-
- (a) alter the hours of operation and maximum stay of a free parking place with space for 6 vehicles in Broomfield Road, Kew;
 - (b) introduce a free parking place in Broomfield Road; and
 - (c) alter a parking place in Princes Road, Kew from a free parking place (maximum stay of 1 hour) to a parking place for permit holders only.
8. Copies of the Draft Orders, plans showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected, quoting Reference 21/08, at:

 - (f) the Civic Centre (Second Floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.

9. Persons wishing to object to or support the proposals or any part thereof should write to the Manager for Transport and Highways, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ on or before 25 March 2008 giving the grounds of their objection. It should be noted that the Council has no statutory duty to consider any objections received in respect of the proposed footway parking exemptions.

SCHEDULE 1

Proposed waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time", other than for item 5(b)

- 1 Langham House Close, Ham:
(a) In the turning head outside Nos 19 to 24 Langham House Close, restrictions in two parts having an overall length of 35 metres, leaving approximately 20 metres of the total perimeter of the turning head as unrestricted parking.
- 2 Melliss Avenue, Kew (that part which is public highway):
(a) Both sides at its junction with Townmead Road.
- 3 Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
(a) Both sides of Mill Hill Road between its junction with Station Road / Cedars Road and Rocks Lane.
- 4 Mowbray Road, Ham:
(a) the north-east side (odd house numbers), the full length, including the turning head at its south-eastern limit, other than these lengths of unrestricted parking:-
(i) outside No 13 Mowbray Road (5.5 metres long); and
(ii) outside Nos 19 to 25 Mowbray Road (21 metres long);

(b) the south-west side (even house numbers), the full length, including the turning head at its south-eastern limit, other than these lengths of unrestricted parking:-
(i) outside Nos 2 to 8 Mowbray Road (41 metres long);
(ii) outside Nos 14 to 16 Mowbray Road (9 metres long); and
(iii) outside Nos 22 to 26 Mowbray Road (5 metres long).

See also the restrictions as described in paragraph 8 below.

- 5 Townmead Road, Kew:
(a) the whole of Townmead Road from Mortlake Road to the Civic Amenity site – "no waiting at any time"; and
(b) in the south-west side of the cul-de-sac section adjoining the Mortlake Crematorium – "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 4.30pm".
- 6 Victoria Cottages, Kew (in the Kew controlled parking zone):
Alter the existing single yellow line to double yellow line restrictions ("no waiting at any time"):-
(a) the whole of the northern side (opposite Nos 1 to 26 Victoria Cottages), but not including the parking bay outside No 27 Victoria Cottages;
(b) the southern side, each of these gaps between existing parking bays:
(i) outside St Luke's Primary School (3 metres long);
(ii) between Nos 6 and 7 Victoria Cottages (4.2 metres long);
(iii) outside No 22 Victoria Cottages (0.5 metres long); and

- (iv) outside No 24 Victoria Cottages (1 metre long).
- 7 At the junction of Ashburnham Road with Mowbray Road, Ham:
(a) on the south-east side of Ashburnham Road and on the south-west side of Mowbray Road, Ham, for distances of between 9 and 15 metres – “no waiting at any time”; and
(b) in Mowbray Road, the north-east side, as described in paragraph 4 above.
- 8 At the junction of Cedars Road with Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
On both sides of Cedars Road, for distances of between 10 and 12 metres – “no waiting at any time”.
- 9 At the junction of Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham:
(a) On the south-west side of Ham Common and on the both sides of Langham House Close, for distances of 10 metres.
- 10 At the junction of Lower Richmond Road with Rosemary Lane and Langdon Place, Mortlake:-
(a) on the south side of Lower Richmond Road and the north-east side of Rosemary Lane, for distances of between 8 and 12 metres;
(b) on the south-west side of Rosemary Lane, from Lower Richmond Road to a point 5 metres beyond its junction with Langdon Place;
(c) on both sides of Langdon Place from its junction with Rosemary Lane to the corner by No 1 Langdon Place, and for a distance of 5 metres from the corner outside No 1 Langdon Place (one side only).
- 11 At the junction of Petersham Road, Richmond with Tree Close, Petersham:
In the access road serving Nos 155 and 155A Petersham Road, the whole perimeter of the island site and on the north and south sides from Petersham Road to Tree Close.
- 12 At the junction of Rocks Lane with Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
On the west side of Rocks Lane, for distances of between 10 and 15 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Proposed changes to school keep clear zig-zag markings

- 1 Broomfield Road, Kew:
Remove the existing school keep clear marking outside Broomfield House School and in its place introduce a free parking bay as specified in Schedule 3.
- 2 Sheen Lane, Richmond:
Extend the existing school keep clear zig-zag markings outside Tower House School (Nos 186-190 Sheen Lane) by a distance of 6 metres giving an overall length of 30.5 metres, and which operate between 8-9.30am and between 2.30-5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

SCHEDULE 3

Proposed free parking place, to operate every day of the year between 10am and 4.30pm, maximum stay 1 hour, no return within 1 hour

Kew Green, Kew, the northern arm, the south side:

Opposite Nos 70 – 82 Kew Green, having an overall length of 31 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

*Proposed changes to parking places in the Richmond Town controlled parking zone
(hours of control are Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8.30am and 6.30pm)*

- 1 Sheen Park, Richmond:
Alter six parking bays (parking meter, with a maximum stay of 2 hours and residents' permit parking between 8.30-9.30am and between 5.30-6.30pm) to residents' permit holder only bays. Located adjacent to flank wall of No 104 Sheen Road; outside No 2 Sheen Park, outside "Watton Court", Sheen Park, adjacent to flank wall of No 138 Sheen Road.
- 2 Sheen Park, Richmond:
Alter four parking bays (parking meter, with a maximum stay of 4 hours and residents' permit parking between 8.30-9.30am and between 5.30-6.30pm) to residents' permit holder only bays. Located adjacent to flank wall of No 38 Sheen Park and adjacent to flank wall of No 66 Sheen Park.

SCHEDULE 5

*Proposed changes to parking places in the Richmond Hill controlled parking zone
(hours of control are Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8.30am and 6.30pm)*

Nightingale Lane, Richmond, the south-east side:

Alter the two existing parking bays (for permit holders only and with space for eight vehicles) to shared-use parking bays (permit holders and pay and display ticket parking with a maximum stay of 4 hours), and extend and merge them into one parking place with space for 12 vehicles, having an overall length of 61.5 metres (starting at a point 21 metres from its junction with Richmond Hill).

SCHEDULE 6

*Proposed changes to parking places in the Kew controlled parking zone
(hours of control are Mondays to Fridays inclusive between 10.00am and 12 noon)*

- 1 Broomfield Road, Kew, the north side:
To the west of its junction with Princes Way, alter a parking place (space for six vehicles) from limited waiting on Mondays to Fridays inclusive between 8-9.30am, between 11.45am-12.15pm and between 2.15-4.00pm with a maximum stay of 20 minutes to free parking with a maximum stay of 1 hour during CPZ hours of control.
- 2 Broomfield Road, Kew, the north side:
To the east of its junction with Princes Way, introduce (in place of a school clearway which is being revoked) a parking place (space for six vehicles) where vehicles may wait free of charge for a maximum stay of 1 hour during CPZ hours of control.
- 3 Princes Road, Kew, the north-west side:
Outside the flank wall of No 11 Broomfield Road and Nos 2 and 2A Princes Road, alter the two existing parking bays (free parking with a maximum stay of 1 hour during CPZ hours of control) with overall space for four vehicles to permit holder only bay.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 21 July 2008 made the above Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Order** will be to introduce waiting restrictions “no waiting at any time” as follows (and specified in Schedule 1):-
 - (a) in parts of these streets:-
 - (i) Melliss Avenue, Kew,
 - (ii) Mill Hill Road, Barnes;
 - (iii) Mowbray Road, Ham;
 - (iv) Townmead Road, Kew; and

- (b) at these road junctions:-
- (i) Ashburnham Road with Mowbray Road, Ham;
 - (ii) Cedars Road with Mill Hill Road;
 - (iii) Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham,
 - (iv) Lower Richmond Road with Rosemary Lane and Langdon Place, Mortlake,
 - (v) Petersham Road, Richmond with Tree Close, Petersham; and
 - (vi) Rocks Lane with Mill Hill Road, Barnes.
3. The general effect of the **Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order** will be to alter school keep clear zig-zag markings in Broomfield Road, Kew and Sheen Lane, Richmond, as specified in Schedule 2.
 4. The general effect of the **Limited Time Parking Places Order** will be to make changes to an existing free time-limited parking place in Broomfield Road, Kew and introduce a similar one in the same street (as specified in Schedule 3, items 1 and 2).
 5. The general effect of the **Kew Parking Places Order** will be to convert a parking place in Princes Road, Kew to a parking place for permit holders only (and specified in Schedule 3, item 3).
 6. The general effect of the **Richmond Town Parking Places Order** will be to alter ten parking meter bays in Sheen Park, Richmond into parking places for residents' parking permit holders only (space for 6 cars overall) or into pay and display parking bays only, with a maximum stay of 2 hours (space for 4 cars overall), as specified in Schedule 4.
 7. The general effect of the **Richmond Hill Parking Places Order** will be to alter two parking bays for permit holders only in Nightingale Lane, Richmond to a parking place for the shared use of permit holders and pay and display parking with a maximum stay of 4 hours, and to extend the length of the parking place, as specified in Schedule 5.
 8. The orders referred to in paragraphs 4, 6 and 7 above will also consolidate the previous orders in respect of the relevant parking places into new orders as a matter of administrative convenience, and these, together with the order mentioned in paragraph 3 above will include minor textual alterations as a consequence of the coming into force of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
 9. The proposals in respect of a new a free time-limited parking place in Kew Green, Kew, of which notice was given on 7 March 2008, are subject to further consideration by the Council.
 10. The proposals in respect of waiting restrictions in Langham House Close, Ham, of which notice was given on 7 March 2008, have been withdrawn (see Schedule 1, item 1).
 11. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 28 July 2008, plans showing the location and effect of the Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 66/08, at:-
 - (a) Castelnau Library, 75 Castelnau, Barnes, London SW13 9RT;
 - (b) East Sheen Library, Sheen Lane Centre, Sheen Lane, London SW14 8LP;

 - (d) Kew Library, 109 North Road, Kew, TW9 4HJ;
 - (e) Richmond Reference Library, Old Town Hall, Whittaker Avenue, Richmond TW9 1TP during opening hours; and
 - (f) the Civic Centre (Second Floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.

SCHEDULE 1

Waiting restrictions "no waiting at any time", other than for item 5(b)

- 13 Langham House Close, Ham:
The proposals in respect of waiting restrictions in the turning head outside Nos 19 to 24 Langham House Close have been withdrawn.
- 14 Melliss Avenue, Kew (that part which is public highway):
Both sides at its junction with Townmead Road.
- 15 Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
Both sides of Mill Hill Road between its junction with Station Road / Cedars Road and Rocks Lane.
- 16 Mowbray Road, Ham:
The north-east side (odd house numbers), the full length. These differ from the restrictions as proposed on 7 March 2008 following local consultation.
- See also the restrictions as described in item 6 below.
- 17 Townmead Road, Kew:
(a) the whole of Townmead Road from Mortlake Road to the Civic Amenity site – "no waiting at any time"; and
(b) in the south-west side of the cul-de-sac section adjoining the Mortlake Crematorium – "no waiting on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 4.30pm".
- 18 At the junction of Ashburnham Road with Mowbray Road, Ham:
(a) on the south-east side of Ashburnham Road and on the south-west side of Mowbray Road, Ham, for distances of between 9 and 15 metres; and
(b) in Mowbray Road, the north-east side, as described in paragraph 4 above.
- 19 At the junction of Cedars Road with Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
On both sides of Cedars Road, for distances of between 10 and 12 metres.

- 20 At the junction of Ham Common with Langham House Close, Ham:
On the south-west side of Ham Common and on the both sides of Langham House Close, for distances of 10 metres.
- 21 At the junction of Lower Richmond Road with Rosemary Lane and Langdon Place, Mortlake:-
- (a) on the south side of Lower Richmond Road and the north-east side of Rosemary Lane, for distances of between 8 and 12 metres;
 - (b) on the south-west side of Rosemary Lane, from Lower Richmond Road to a point 5 metres beyond its junction with Langdon Place; and
 - (c) on both sides of Langdon Place from its junction with Rosemary Lane to the corner by No 1 Langdon Place, and for a distance of 5 metres from the corner outside No 1 Langdon Place (one side only).
- 22 At the junction of Petersham Road, Richmond with Tree Close, Petersham:
In the access road serving Nos 155 and 155A Petersham Road, the whole perimeter of the island site and on the north and south sides from Petersham Road to Tree Close.
- 23 At the junction of Rocks Lane with Mill Hill Road, Barnes:
On the west side of Rocks Lane, for distances of between 10 and 15 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Changes to school clearway zig-zag markings ("no stopping" during the hours indicated)

- 3 Broomfield Road, Kew:
Remove the existing school keep clear marking outside Broomfield House School and in its place introduce a free parking bay as specified in Schedule 4.
- 4 Sheen Lane, Richmond:
Extend the existing school keep clear zig-zag markings outside Tower House School (Nos 186-190 Sheen Lane) by a distance of 6 metres giving an overall length of 30.5 metres, and which operate between 8-9.30am and between 2.30-5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

SCHEDULE 3

Changes to parking places in the Kew controlled parking zone (hours of control are Mondays to Fridays inclusive between 10am and 12 noon)

- 4 Broomfield Road, Kew, the north side:
To the west of its junction with Princes Way, alter the existing free time-limited parking place (space for six vehicles) from one which operates on Mondays to Fridays inclusive between 8-9.30am, between 11.45am-12.15pm and between 2.15-4.00pm allowing maximum stay of 20 minutes to one which operates during CPZ hours allowing maximum stay of 1 hour.
- 5 Broomfield Road, Kew, the north side:
To the east of its junction with Princes Way, introduce (in place of a school clearway which is being revoked) a free time-limited parking place (space for six vehicles) which operates during CPZ hours allowing maximum stay of 1 hour.
- 6 Princes Road, Kew, the north-west side:

Outside the flank wall of No 11 Broomfield Road and Nos 2 and 2A Princes Road, alter the two existing parking bays (with overall space for four vehicles) from free time-limited parking allowing a maximum stay of 1 hour during CPZ hours to a permit holder only bay.

SCHEDULE 4

*Changes to parking places in the Richmond Town controlled parking zone
(hours of control are Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8.30am and 6.30pm)*

Sheen Park, Richmond:

- (a) changes a total of 6 parking bays, currently used as meter parking bays with a maximum stay of 4 hours and where vehicles which display a valid residents' or residents visitors permit may park between 8.30-9.30am and between 5.30-6.30pm, into parking spaces for the sole use of vehicles which display a valid residents' or residents visitors permit;
- (b) changes a total of 2 parking bays, currently used as meter parking bays with a maximum stay of 2 hours and where vehicles which display a valid residents' or residents visitors permit may park between 8.30-9.30am and between 5.30-6.30pm, into parking spaces for the sole use of vehicles which display a valid residents' or residents visitors permit; and
- (c) changes a total of 2 parking bays, currently used as meter parking bays with a maximum stay of 2 hours and where vehicles which display a valid residents' or residents visitors permit may park between 8.30-9.30am and between 5.30-6.30pm, into pay and display parking bays with a maximum stay of 2 hours.

SCHEDULE 5

*Changes to parking places in the Richmond Hill controlled parking zone
(hours of control are Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between 8.30am and 6.30pm)*

Nightingale Lane, Richmond, the south-east side:

Alter the two existing parking bays (for permit holders only and with space for eight vehicles) to shared-use parking bays (permit holders and pay and display ticket parking with a maximum stay of 4 hours), and extend and merge them into one parking place with space for 12 vehicles, having an overall length of 61.5 metres (starting at a point 21 metres from its junction with Richmond Hill).
