THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (KEW) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 3) ORDER 200*

Made: 25 July 2005

Coming into operation: 1 August 2005

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991(b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 August 2005 and may be cited as The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Kew) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2005.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Kew) (Parking Places) Order 2004(d), as amended, shall have effect as though there were added to the items in Schedule 3 to that Order the

Following a review of the parking provision in the Kew controlled parking zone, this Order introduces an additional parking bay for the convenience of residents in Victoria Cottages, Kew..

RELATING TO VICTORIA COTTAGES, KEW

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make an Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 51 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce a parking place on the north side of Victoria Cottages opposite Nos 24 and 25 Victoria Cottages, in which only vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit, a residents' visitors permit or a business parking permit may be left during the operational hours of the Kew controlled parking zone (10am to 12 noon, Mondays to Fridays).
- 3. The Council hereby gives notice that it intends to introduce the waiting restrictions "no waiting between 10am and 12 noon, Mondays to Fridays" on the remaining length of Victoria Cottages in accordance with the provisions of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No 28) Order 2004, which came into force on 1st April 2004.
- 4. Copies of the draft Parking Places Order, the Waiting and Loading Restriction Order, a plan showing the location and effect of the proposals and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Parking Places Order can be inspected for a period of 21 days from the date of this Notice, quoting reference 21/05, at:

 - (b) Richmond Reference Library, Old Town Hall, Whittaker Avenue, Richmond TW9 1TP during opening hours, and
 - (c) the Civic Centre (Second Floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.
- Persons wishing to object to or support the proposals or any part thereof should write to the Head of Transport Planning Service, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ within 21 days of the date of this Notice giving the grounds of their objection.
